SURPLARY

DURING HIS AUGUST 14-15 CONSULTATIONS WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF CHINA'S MINISTRIES OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, DEFENSE, ENERGY AND CHEMICAL INDUSTRY, ACDA DIRECTOR LEBNAN SAID THAT THE HISTORIC CHARGES IN THE WORLD OVER THE PAST TWO YEARS AND RECENT SUCCESSFUL U.S.-PRC COOPERATION ON HONPROLIFERATION HELD GREAT PROMISE FOR THE FUTURE STABILITY OF THE WORLD. HE EXPRESSED APPRECIATION FOR CHINA'S EFFORTS TO COMBAT PROLIFERATION ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA, BUT SAID THE U.S. STILL HAD CONCERNS ABOUT NORTH KOREA'S HUCLEAR PROGRAM AND URGED CHINESE EFFORTS TO PERSUADE THE NORTH TO CONCLUDE A BILATERAL INSPECTION REGIME WITH THE SOUTH. AMBASSADOR LEHNAN CONDENDED THE PRC'S DECISION TO JOIN THE NPT, ENCOURAGED CHINA TO MAKE FULL-SCOPE SAFEGUARDS A CONDITION FOR NUCLEAR COOPERATION WITH THIRD COUNTRIES AND URGED THE CHINESE TO SUPPORT AN INDEFINITE EXTENSION OF THE NPT AT THE 1995 EXTENSION CONFERENCE. HE ASKED FOR CHINESE VIEWS OH HOW TO HOVE FORWARD WITH THE INITIATIVE TO HOLD FIVE-POWER TALKS ON PROLIFERATION IN SOUTH ASIA AND REITERATED U.S. CONCERN ABOUT POSSIBLE CONTINUED CHINESE INVOLVEMENT IN PAKISTAM'S NUCLEAR PROGRAM. URGED THE CHINESE TO LINIT THE YIELD OF FUTURE NUCLEAR TESTS, ONLY TO CONDUCT THEN FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENSURING THE SAFETY AND RELIABILITY OF THE CHINESE ARSENAL AND TO SHOW RESTRAINT WITH REGARD TO THE

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR NORMAN WILF, SPECIAL ASSISTANT BRENDA KUDSON, VICTOR ROSTOV FROM DOD, DOROTHY DOMRELLY FROM DOE AND BURT NOFFMAN FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE. THE DOM: POLITINGOUNS AND POLOFFS ACCOMPANIED THE LEHMAN PARTY FOR ALL MEETINGS.

AMBASSADOR ROY ATTENDED THE CALL ON FIN GIAM AND A LUNCH NOSTED BY VFM TIAN, AND HE AND THE DATE ATTENDED THE CALL CH DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF XU XIN. 6. FORMAL CONSULTATIONS WERE HELD FOR THREE HOURS ON AUGUST 14 WITH A DELEGATION READED BY VICE FOREIGN MINISTER TIAN ZENGPEL. THE CHINESE SIDE INCLUDED: QIN HUASUN, DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND CONFERENCES, FOREIGN MINISTRY: SHA ZUKANG, 1/0 DEPARTMENT COUNSELLOR; ZHANG WEIDONG, DEPUTY DIVISION CHIEF AND GAO INENDONG, FIRST SECRETARY IN THE 1/O DEPARTMENT: SHI LONGZHUANG. 7. OH AUGUST IS AMBASSADOR LEHMAN PAID COURTEST CALLS ON PLA DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF XU XIN. GENERAL XU WAS ACCOMPANIED BY SENIOR COLONEL THAN MACHAI, DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF INNO FOREIGN AFFAIRS BUSEAU FAB); SENIOR COLONEL DU LIANYAN; SRIEF OF FAN'S AMERICAN AND COCEANIAN DIVISION, AND COLONELS ZHANG LIANTAI AND JIANG YULIN OF FAB'S U.S. DESK, AS WELL AS THE FOREIGN MINISTRY'S SHA ZUXANG AND CAPTAIN TANC CHERG. AMBASSADOR LEHMAN CALLED LATER ON FOREIGN MINISTER DIAN GICHEN, WHO YAS ACCOMPANIED BY 170 DIRECTOR RIN.

FORMAL CONSULTATIONS WITH VEH TIAN

REVIEWING THE GREAT CHANGES IN THE WORLD OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS, U.S.-CHINA COOPERATION ON NONPROLIFERATION AND CURRENT MONPROLIFERATION CONCERNS. HE SAID TRATTHE INCREASING ACCEPTANCE OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS NAD HELPED THE NEWLY INDEPENDENT STATES OF THE FORMER SOVIET UNION TO ACCEPT JOINING THE MET AS MON-WOLLEAGHER ON STATES AND TO ACCEPT THE PROVISIONS OF THE FROLIFERATION CONCERNS, MANY OF WHICH THE U.S. AND CHIMA WERE WORKING TOCETHER TO ADDRESS; E.G. THE RIDDLE EAST, SOUTH ASIA AND THE KOREAN PEHINSKA. HE POINTED OUT THAT THE PRESIDENT HAD RECETLY TAKEN SEVERAL WHILATERAL STEPS TO REDUCE THE U.S. NUCLEAR ARSENAL, FOR EXAMPLE, BY REMOVING TACTICAL MUCLEAR MEAPONS FROM U.S. NAVAL SHIPS AND FROM LAND DEPLOYMENT OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES.

NUCLEAR TESTING, FISSILE MATERIAL

9. AMBASSADOR LEHMAN TOLD TIAN THAT THE UNITED STATES HAD DECIDED TO LINIT THE NUMBER OF MUCLEAR TESTS IT

WOULD CONDUCT, TO LIMIT THE VIELD OF THOSE TESTS. AND TO CONDUCT TESTS ONLY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND RELIABILITY OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS; NOT FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING NEW WEAPONS. HE ALSO DISCUSSED THE W.S. DECISION TO STOP PRODUCING WEAPONS-GRADE PLUTONION AND HIGHLY-ENRICHED URANIUM. HE URGED CHINA TO TAXE SIMILAR STEPS.

FULL-SCOPE SAFEGUARDS

17. AMBASSADOR LERMAR URGED CHINA TO INSIST ON FULL-SCOPE SAFEGUARDS AS A PRECONDITION FOR MUCLEAR COOPERATION WITH THIRD COUNTRIES, POINTING OUT TRAT 27 MEMBERS OF THE MUCLEAN SUPPLIERS GROUP REQUIRED FULL-SCOPE SAFEGUARDS FOR MUCLEAR COOPERATION. SE ADDED THAT 145 NON-MUCLEAR COURTRIES MIN MERE SIGNATORIES TO THE MPT HAD ARREADY AGREED TO IMPLEMENT FULL-SCOPE SAFEGUARDS. TRUS, FIRE-SCOPE SAFEGUARDS WAS RECOMING AN INTERNATIONAL MOMPROLIFERATION STANDARD.

AMBASSADOR LEMMAN BRIEFED TIAM ON RECENT

15. AMBASSADOR LEHMAN TOLD TIAN THAT WHILE THE U.S. WAS PLEASED THAT NORTH KOREA HAD IMPROVED ITS COOPERATION WITH THE 1AEA, THE U.S. WAS STILL COMERNED ABOUT THE DIRECTION OF THE HORTH KOREAN HUCLEAR PROGRAM. THE IAEA INSPECTION HAD SHOWN THAT NORTH KOREA HAD INDEED BEEN ENGAGED IN REPROCESSING, SOMETHING WHICH THE HORTH KOREANS HAD CONSISTENTLY DEMIED AND WHICH WAS PROHIBITED BY THE NORTH/SOUTH NON-HUCLEAR DECLA RATION. IT WAS VERY IMPORTANT, HE CONTINUED, FOR NORTH AND SOUTH KOREA TO IMPLEMENT AM EFFECTIVE BILATERAL INSPECTION REGIME. THE U.S. HAD CONTRIBUTED TO THIS PROCESS BY AGREEING TO ALLOW INSPECTIONS OF U.S. HILITARY BASES IN SOUTH KOREA. HI ADDED THAT THE U.S. KHEW CHIMA HAD BEEN HELPFUL WITH THE NORTH KOREANS AND URGED CHIMA TO CONTINUE TO MAKE EFFORTS IN THIS AREA.

19. DURING A AUGUST IS CALL ON PLA DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF XV XIN. AXBASSADOR LERNAN EXPHASIZED THE NEED FOR CONTINUED U.S.-PRC COOPERATION IN THE MIDDLE FACT. SOUTH ASIA AND THE KOREAN PENINSULA.

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28. AMBASSADOR LEHMAN RESPONDED THAT WHILE DEVELOPMENTS ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA WERE ENCOURAGING, THE JAEA INSPECTION HAD CONFIRMED A MORTH KOREAN REPROCESSING PLANT, WITH HO ECONOMIC PURPOSE. HE EMPHASIZED, IT WAS NOT IN CHINA'S NOR THE U.S.

INTEREST FOR NORTH KOREA TO ACTIEVE HUCLEAR MEAFORS
PRODUCTION. AMBASSADOR LEHNAN OBSERVED, THIS WAS NOT
JUST A REGIONAL ISSUE; IT HAD GLOBAL IMPLICATIONS
BECAUSE OF ITS IMPACT ON SOUTH ASIA. THE FORMER SOVIET
UNION STATES: AND IN PARTICULAR, JAPAN.

MPT EXTENSION

17. AMBASSADOR LEHMAN DISCUSSED THE 1995 CONFERENCE ON THE EXTENSION OF THE MPT. SOME COUNTRIES, HE OBSERVED, MISHED TO PUT TIME LIMITS ON THE EXTENSION OF THE MPT OR TO CONDITION ITS EXTENSION ON THE CONCLUSION OF A COMPREHENSIVE TEST BAN. THE U.S. HE SAID, FAVORED AN INDEFINITE EXTENSION, WHICH WAS PROVIDED FOR IN THE TREATY. FURTHER, WE DID NOT BELIEVE THE EXTENSION SHOULD BE CONDITIONAL.

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
