Honduras, especially as they relate to U.S. policies and interests; and promotion of commercial, cultural and other exchanges.

B. Specific Objectives during the rating period include encouraging, as appropriate, the consolidation of constitutional government; advising the Honduran Government in the formulation of sound economic policies; guiding the USG's increased economic and development assistance efforts in Honduras which surpassed the \$80 million level in FY-82; overseeing a military assistance and training effort in Honduras which tripled in size during the same period; and assisting the GOH in the improvement of its ability to counter growing terrorist activity in Honduras.
