On 6-19-72 after briefing you concerning developments in this case, I conferred with the Attorney General at 2:00 p. m.

The Attorney General agreed with your suggestion that there should be an aggressive investigative approach to this case. He suggested that dissemination be deferred until the facts have been rounded out. He agreed that a sweep of Democratic National Committee headquarters was a logical investigative step but he suggested that in view of the sensitive nature of this case you might want to personally contact Democratic Chairman O'Brien to suggest this.
