**RE: Rosenfeld v. Department of Justice: Subjects and Files which appear not to have been searched or processed.**

Dear Mark,

We are currently in the midst of review of the documents provided in response to the partial settlement of Mr. Rosenfeld's FOIA litigation.

It appears that certain subjects and certain files relating to subjects were not processed for release. I am providing you with a list of these subjects and request that you advise me whether documents relating to these subjects were processed and if so, why they don't appear on the inventories or search slips and why no records were provided. If no documents were processed, then please advise why no documents were processed.

In some of the following cases, no records at all were produced. These are on List A accompanied by a specification of the field office from which these records were requested. In other cases, no records from a particular field office were processed and we do not see any indication that a search was conducted at that field office. These subjects are set forth in List B along with the field office for which it appears no search was conducted. All of the subjects are clearly within the scope of Mr. Rosenfeld's request and are specifically named in the Stipulation and Order filed October 23, 1995 delineating the subjects covered by the request.




