RECE HAD BEEN APPROACHED BY CARABALLO (FNU) FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR AN OPERATION INVOLVING THE BLOWING UP OF A SOVIET OR CUBAN VESSEL IN VERACRUZ, MEXICO. CARABALLO SAID THAT HE HAD ALL THE CONTACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH ANY DEMOLÍTION OPERATION IN MEXICO AND THAT HE COULD DO THE JOB IN VERACRUZ FOR \$3,000. CARABALLO WAS TOLD THAT RECE MIGHT USE HIM AND HIS CONTACTS, BUT THAT SOMEONE ELSE WOULD BE SENT TO MEXICO WITH HIM TO PLACE THE DEMOLÍTIONS ABOARD THE VESSEL.
