The Special Commando Unit of the Guatemalan Army (SCUGA, government-sponsored terrorist organization which has heretofore been used primarily for assassinations and political abductions) is planning to expand its operations to include an intelligence-gathering. [REDACTED] The SCUGA intelligence network will endeavor to collect information from informants and through interrogations of captured Communist revolutionaries. It will also attempt to recruit informants from among those who have been captured by action units of the SCUGA.
2. [REDACTED]
3. The principal aim of [REDACTED] will be collecting intelligence. The members will be required, however, to undertake special assignments from time to time. An example of the latter was the assassination of the Acting Mayor of Retalhuleu, who was shot to death by members of the SCUGA intelligence network.¹ The SCUGA intelligence network has also been assigned the task of assassinating Colonel Luis Morales Malgar, Governor of the Department of Retalhuleu.
