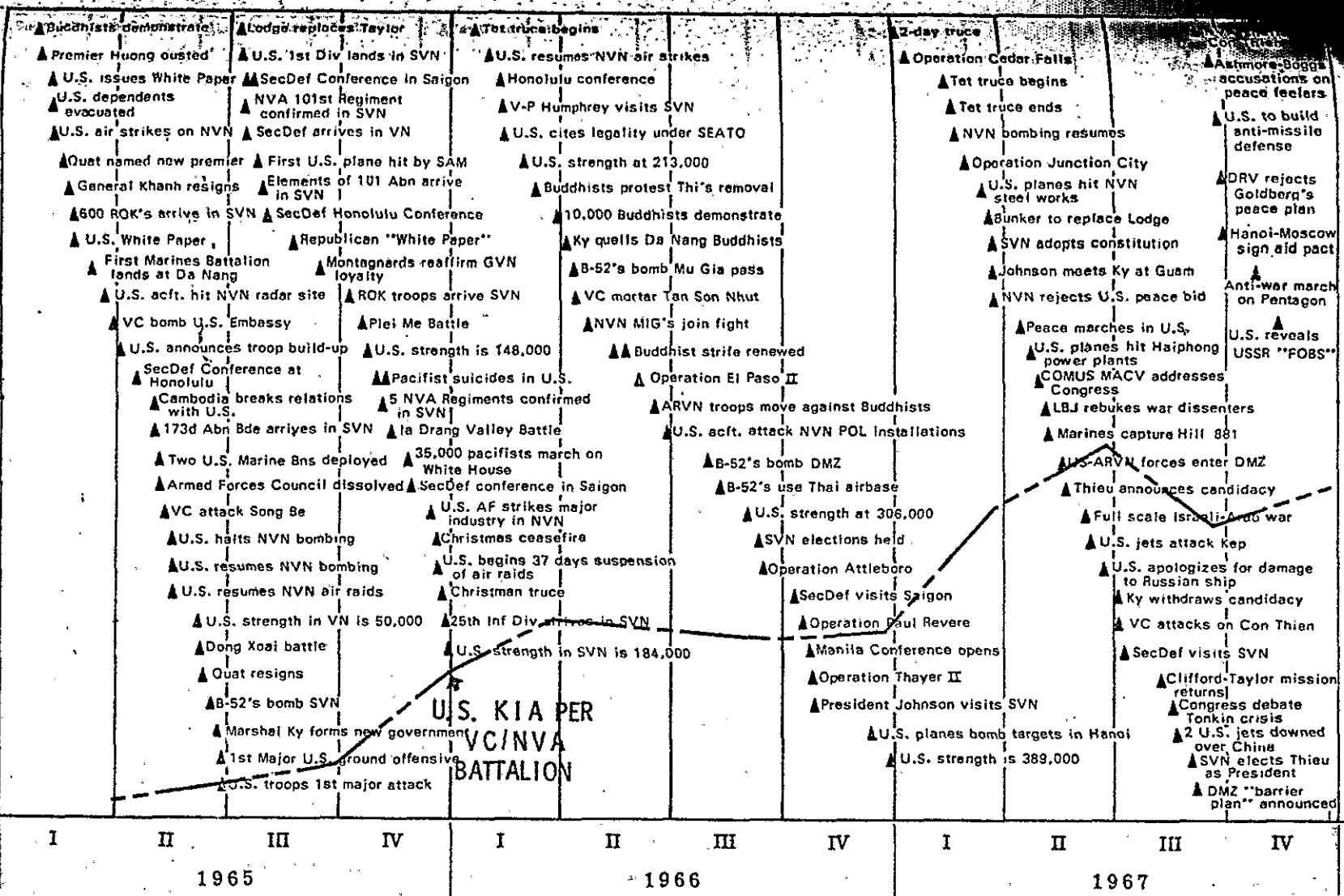




U.S. KIA Per Enemy Battalion

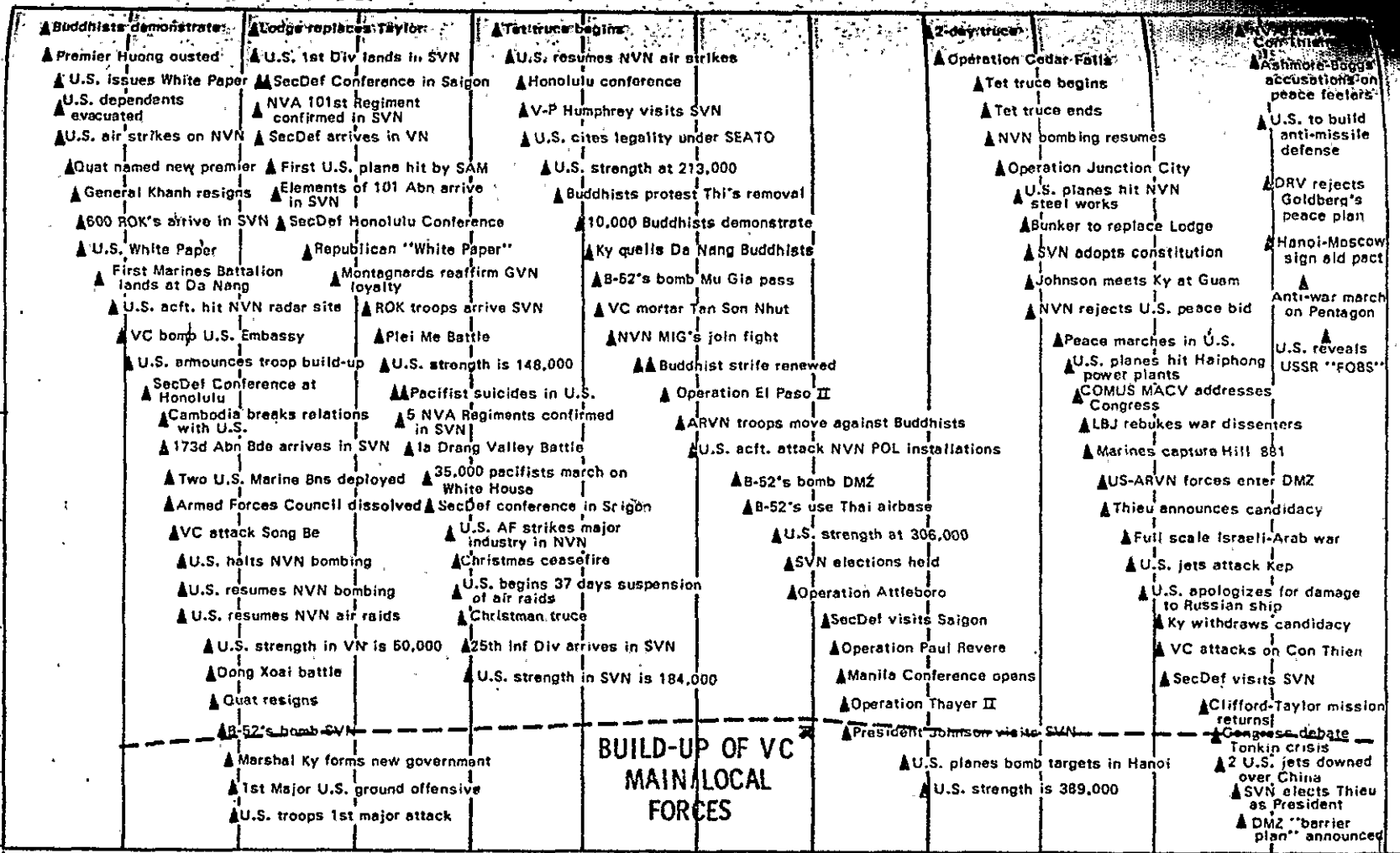
