Dear Senator Cohen:

Thank you for your letter of December 22 forwarding the letter from [REDACTED] concerning the safety of Senator Gonzalez, who disappeared in the Dominican Republic on May 28, 1991.

We agree with [REDACTED] that this is a matter of great concern. Our Embassy in Santo Domingo expressed a strong interest in this case, and remains in touch with the Dominican National Police about the investigation. Although Dominican police investigators settled the passenger's last known whereabouts, the leads they have followed so far have not resulted in an explanation of what happened to him. The case remains open, however, and we will continue to give our support to the investigation in every way possible.

We hope this information is helpful in responding to your constituent's concerns. Please do not hesitate to contact us if we can be of further assistance.
