SUEJECT	: Anti-Tudeh Activities	of	Zaheli	Government	
REFERENCE					:

- 1. General Radsetan, Military Governor of Tehran, has been assigned by Frime Minister Zahedi task of directing countryvide crackdown on Tudeh Party.
- 2. As of 5 September Dadsetan had arrested 412 Tudeh members including: Norteza Casemi, Bavud Noruzi and Mahmud Zhandi, whom Dedsetan considers numbers of Tudeh Central Committee.
- 3. Rank-and file Tuleh members, who are arrested, are to be banished. to Luristan.
- 4. Three. Tudeh arranals and "several" printing presses have been scied.
- 5. Nadscian claims "part of" Tudeh headquarters has been raided and cartured documents turned over to Iranian G-2.
- 6. Tudeh Farty is now printing newspapers in Soviet Fatessy. Newspapers are transported in diploratic cars to Rusanian Legation. There Tudeh newspapers are placed in tundles with newspaper etteleat and keyhan on top. Newspapers are then taken by diplomatic cars to four distribution points: Javadiyeh (near railroad station); Moftabad (near Deshan Tappeh Airfield); Majidieh Brewery; and one undetermined point. From these points, bundles are thrown into unlicensed jeeps which three bundles on streets.
- 7. Within Government now ministers are generally agreed on ousting Tudeh members from Government Ministries. Ministers do not know Tudeh members and must uncover them. Zahedi continue to press for action.

- 8. Tudeh Party is now underground but is trying to form coalition of pro-Mossadeq elements. Dadaetan states emphatically that he has severed Mossadeq-Tudeh alliance and that Bazzar has abandoned Mossadeq. Dadaetan is watching closely for possible sources of financial support for Tudeh Party.
