- S: To bring you back between your two trip to Europe and have him on the 24th and 25th of May and you would leave again on the 26th.
- K: Isn't the 26th the meeting.
- S: The 26th is. You would have to leave on the 25th.
- K: How about the 28th and 29th. I don't know what day in the week that is.
- S: That is a weekend. Will you be back.
- K: I could be back for that but that want help us much will it.
- S: That is a Friday and Sat.
- K: You see if I miss the CENTO meeting in which the Turks play a big role in order to see a Greek...
- S: I don't think should. But if we had it
- K: When is the NATO meeting.
- S: The 20th and 21st, I think.
- K: You want him when?
- S: I was thinking about the 24th and 2tth.
- K: It means I would have to leave on the 25th and why won't it work on say June 3 and 4 or 4 and 5.
- S: Carlos is coming on the 2nd and 3rd and you also cannot put put two of them back to back. You run into problsm, for example on Blair HOuse, and you have to give

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- at least a day in between because they usually stay over
- K: Why can't he come on the 12th or 14th.
- S: I have not gone back to ask if he can do that.
- K: Try that first. If that fails then I wil
- S: 0.K.
- K: I had that group in again this morning -- Absire Group. They feel that the behavior towards Nixon is unbelievable. What possessed the President yesterday to pop off again.
- S: I have no idea. It came right out of the blue. He had not sounded that way when we talked to him. I have no idea. I was not in that interview. That is the first time he himself has done that.
- K: Makes him look weak to say Nixon can hurt him.
- S: Of course. A terrible thing to say.
- K: He should say I don't see what possible effect Nixon could have on my campaing.
- S: That is what he said at the press conference but...
- K: I don't know why he keeps saying that he does not speak for us when all Nixon is saying that he wants friendship.
- S: That as bad yesterday. I don't know why he did it.
- K: O.K.
- S: Henry, do I understand on that Chadrin case we should on (trade).
- K: Nonsense. If her guy want to go to that guy Vogel....
- S: You don't want to pursue it.
- K: Impossible.
- S: I don't got this third hand.

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- K: I said if she wants to go to Vogel that is all right. You know these guys feel very strongly that the President is making a mistake not claiming a success in foreign policy.
- S: I think that is right. I think he is. I think he should not be defensive. He should start talking about his foreign policy. We will try to get him to do it.
- K: I doubt it.
- S: I don't know. They political guys around him are just insane. The Harlow group I don't know why they are not talking to the President.
- K: I have told him five times and he will not call him in. Harlow says if he requested an appointment, the guys he would **EXITIME** criticize would be in there with him.
- S: They are political too.
- K: They say if he does not get out ahead soon in foreign policy I will be destroyed.
- S: Yep. I will talk to him. Maybe if we get a few short speeches that he can use on some of these things some positive statements. Get them written up maybe he will use them. I will have someone start on some of those.
- K: O.K.
- S: Have a good trip and give Nancy our love.
