- (1) KIGALI, COMD SEC RIGALI HAD A MEETING WITH THE HOME MINISTER OF ENANDA ABOUT THE PROHIBITION OF DEMONSTRATIONS ON WITH "N 1.5 KM FROM THE END COMPOUND. CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT FIR IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. ESTABLISHED 6 CHECK POINTS AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KNSA, PROVIDED 2 UNMO ESCORTS TO GENUARMERIE, 2 FOR RRE, 1 FOR HERUGER CAMP AND 1 TO TANZANIAN BORDER, ALSO PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, RES AND UNDER SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RFF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, THE PREMATURE, FORCE BQ AND SEC NO AND PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE AIRPORT OF KIGALI, BURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION FOR THE PRIME WINDSTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AND FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS, AND TO THE RESIDENCE OF SRSG.
- (2) DMZ. RGF SOLDERES INTENDED LOCTING SHOPS AT RUHENGERI SECAUSE OF NUT SEING SERVED WITH BEANS IN THEIR MEALS. THE SUPPLIERS CLAIM THAT THEY HAVE NOT BREN PAID FOR THEIR SERVICES SINCE A LONG TIME AND THEY REFUSE FURTHER SUFFLY. PROVIDED ESCORT TO JAAR FOR POOD DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL CARE FOR CHILDREN AT RWANKURA AND GASTZA. ALSO MONITORED THE FOOD DISTRIBUTION FROM LCRC AT NYAMUGALI. AID WAS GIVEN TO 4.200 REFUGEES.

A PROCRAM WAS AGREED UPON TO START AN OFFICIAL RECCE OF THE RGF ZONE. RGF AGREED ALSO ON CO-LOCATION OF MILOS HO AT RUHENGER! AND BUTARE.
- D. UNOMUR. THE SITUATION IN THE UNOMUR AREA IS CALM. UGANDA IS CHSERVING LIBERATION DAY TODAY 26 JAN. IT SEEMS THAT LUBIRINI/KASHEKYE AREA IS CONFIRMED AS A CROSSING POINT FOR REFUGEES. A GROUP OF REFUGEES, ABOUT 10 PEOPLE WITH APPROXIMATELY 200 COWS CHOSSED THE PORDER AT KASHEKYE TO RWANDA AT 251215 JAN 94. IT TAME OUT FROM DISCUSSION THAT THIS PEOPLE CAME FROM THE REFUGEE CAMP LOCATED AT MBARARA CARRYING PERMISSION CERTIFICATE FROM MBARARA AUTHORITY, ANOTHER GROUP OF 10 '70 15 REFUGEES CROSSED THE BORDER AROUND 15.00 HRS WITH AFFROXIMATELY 100 TO 150 COWS AND WITH LOT OF LUGGAGES THROUGH LUBIRIZE AND KASHEKYE. NO INFO REGARDING THEIR LOCATION OF CRIGIN COULD CONFIRM. SPECIAL PTL WAS CONDUCTED TO FIND A PROPER PLACE FOR A SECOND REPEATER STATION FOR COMMUNICATIONS IN THE UNCHUR AREA. TOTAL & VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER AT GATUNA. TWO OF

THEM CAME FROM UGANDA TO SWANDA WITH TWO PASSENGERS CARRYING SMALL OUANTITY OF MITODKE. 4 VEHICLES WITH 8 PASSENGERS CAME FROM RWANDA. THEY HAD NO LUGGAGE WITH THEM.
