# SITREP COVERING PERIOD 270600B JAN TO 280600B JAN 94.

I. GEN\_SITUATION. TENSE. THE TROUBLES AROUND THE CND COMPOUND REPORTED AS PER DAILY SITREP 25/26 JAN 94 ARE COMING FROM A FEELING OF INSECURITY OF THE LOCAL POPULATION IN THAT AREA. THE PREFECT OF KIGALI CITY HAD A THREE HOURS CONVERSATION IN THE OPEN WITH THESE PEOPLE. KIGALI SECTOR COMMANDER ATTENDED ALTHOUGH WE HAD NOT BEEN INVITED. THE COMMENTS OF THE CDE WERE SUBSEQUENTLY MISQUOTED IN THE LOCAL MEDIA. THE MEETING WAS ANTIFED FROM THE START. IT WAS SAID THAT A GENEARMERIE CDR WILL BE INSTALLED PERMANENTLY IN THE AREA.

### II. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. POLITICAL BROAD BASED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT NOT YET INSTALLED. SRSG WELD A MARATHON 4 HOUR MEETING WITH MRND AND RPF LHADERSHIF. THERE IS CONSIDERABLE MOVEMENT ON BOTH SIDES, THE RESULTS ARE THAT AN OFFER WAS MADE BY RPF. MRND IS YET TO RESPOND.

### B. MILITARY.

- (1) RGF. RGF TROCHS (TARRIED OUT FIRING PRACTICE AT KANOMBE, A REQUEST TO MOVE A COMMANDO BATTALION FROM RUHENGERI AREA TO KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA WAS DENIED BY US. IT WAS DERMED AS A REINFORCEMENT. THEY STATED THAT IT WAS DUE TO RESUPPLY PROBLEMS IN THE NORTH.
- (2) RPP. RPF VOLLRY-BALL TEAM WAS BROUGHT GVFP FROM MULINDI IN GROUP TO TAKE PART IN A VOLLRY-BALL TOURNAMENT TH'S WEEK-END ORGANIZED BY THE NATIONAL VOLLBY-BALL FEDERATION.

## III. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. HOS. THE JOINT COMMITTEE MRETING TO BE HALD AT NGONDORE ON 27 JAN 94 WAS CANCELLED BY FC BECAUSE BOTH GENDARMERIE AND ARMY CHIEFS OF STAFF BACKED OUT AT THE LAST MINUTE. WITHOUT THEIR PRESENCE (OR AT LEAST THE CHIEF OF STAFF OF THE ARMY) WE COULD NOT TAKE CEPTAIN FUNDAMENTAL DECISIONS ON THE DEMOBILIZATION STAFFING. DEC MET RCP CHIEP OF STAFF, GEN NSABIMANA, AT ABOUT 15.00 HRS AND FORWARDED PROTEST AGAINST INTENDED PGF TROOPS MOVEMENT TO THE KIGALT WEAPON SECURE AREA. 15 RUSSIAN UNMOS ARRIVED IN THE MISSION AREA. TODAY'S TOTAL FORCE STRENGTH IS 1316.

PARTICULAR ON KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PTL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. ESTABLISHED 6 CHECK POINTS AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KWSA. PROVIDED 6 UNMO ESCORTS TO RPF AND 1 TO UNAMIE PERSONNEL. PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, 2 FOR RPF AND 2 POR UNAMIR. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RPF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY. - (2) <u>DMZ</u>. ASSISTED PUBLIC PROSECUTOR PERSONNEL FOR AN INVESTIGATION AT BUTETE (7145). FOUR ROBBERS WERE ARRESTED AND TAKEN AT EUHENGER! PRISON. MONITORED FOOD DISTRIBUTION BY ICRC TO 5.400 PEOPLE IN NYAMUGALI. ALSO CONDUCTED ROUTINE PTM.
- C. MILOB. CONDUCTED ESCORTS FOR APC/TRUCK CONVOY FROM/TO TANZANIAN BORDER. RGF AND RPF MILOB SEC CONDUCTED RECCE WITHIN OAR.
- D. UNOMUR. THE SITUATION IN THE UNOMUR AREA IS CALM. CMO AND SOME UNMOS ATTENDED A CIVIL/MILITARY PARADE AT KABALE. ON 261500 JAN 94 FIVE REFUGEES CROSSED THE BORDER WITH THEIR HERD AND LURGAGE. 6 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER INTO RWANDA. 15 PERSONS WITH FOOD AND PERSONAL LUGGAGE WERE INVOLVED. 1 VEHICLE WITH 4 PASSENGERS CROSSED THE BORDER INTO UGANDA, NOTHING SIGNIFICANT WAS FOUND.
