SITREP COVERING PERIOD 050600Z MAR TO 060600Z MAR 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. NO MAJOR INCIDENT TOOK PLACE IN KIGALI CITY AND THE SITUATION IS CALM. EXCEPT SOUND OF TWO GRENADES EXPLOSION WERE HEARD.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. BROAD BASED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT NOT YET INSTALLED. NEGOTIATIONS ONGOING. A MEETING HELD AT MULINDI BETWEEN MINISTER OF FORGEIN AFFAIRS, TANZANIAN AMBASSADOR AND RPF LEADERSHIP. THEY DISCUSSED ABOUT CURRENT NEGOTIATION REGARDING INSTALLATION OF BBTG. THE MEETING WAS NOT PRODUCTIVE BECAUSE THE RPF REGRETTED THE CURRENT ACHIEVEMENTS IN NEGOTIATION.

(1) ON 052030 MAR 94 KIBAT PATROL INFORMED THAT THERE WAS A ROAD BLOCK AT GIKONDO AREA.

(2) ON 052040 MAR 94 ONE WHITE WOMAN WAS ATTACKED BY SOME BANDITS NEAR KIGALI NIGHT CLUB. AT THAT TIME KIBAT PATROL PRESENT THERE FIRED ONE ROUND WARNING SHOT AND RESCUED THE WOMAN. THE BANDITS FLED AWAY.

(3) ON 052030 MAR 94 ONE CIVILIAN REPORTED THAT TWO INTERHEMWE PERSONNEL ATTACKED HIS VEHICLE AND ARRESTED ONE PERSON AND TOOK HIS PASSPORT AND ALSO SEIZED HIS VEHICLE NO AC-2003 NEAR MAGERWA IN GIKONDO AREA. THE CASE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO GENDARMERIE FOR INVESTIGATION.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. ON 05 MAR 94 DFC VISITED MULINDI TO ARRANGE FOR RESUMPTION OF JOINT MILITARY COMMISSION MEETING FOR WEDNESDAY 09 MAR 94.

B. UNOMUR. UNOMUR OPERATIONAL AREA IS CALM. ACOMO RETURNED FROM KAMPALA HE CALLED ON THE AMBASSADOR OF USA, EGYPT, TANZANIA, RWANDA, UK, NIGERIA, KENYA, FRANCE, ARMY COMMANDER OF UGANDA AND REP OF UNDP. TEN UNMO'S FROM ZIMBABWE ARRIVED IN KABALE TO REPLACE THE FORMER ZIMBABWE CONTINGENT WHICH LEFT ON 5TH MAR 94. AT KABALE PATROL CARRIED OUT AS PER PROGRAMME. THE FOLLOWING CIVILIAN BORDER CROSSINGS WERE REPORTED AT KATUNA:

C. DMZ. OPERATIONAL SITUATION IN DMZ REPORTED TO BE CALM. TEAM A CONDUCTED PATROLS TO RUHENGARI, NTARUKA, KIDAKO, KAGOGO AND CYANIKA. TEAM B CARRIED OUT LONG RANGE PATROL TO KALINGOLERA (A7425), KIRAMBO (A8235), BUTARO (A8244), KAGOGO (A4775), KIDAKO (A4772) AND RUHENGARI. TEAM C CARRIED OUT PATROL IN OWN AOR. TEAM D ESCORTED A 4 MEN TEAM LED BY MR RUTAGENGWA THEONESTE TO INVESTIGATE HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES BY RGF SOLDIERS AT NYAGATARE (B4169). THE TEAM ENCOUNTERED NUMEROUS DELAYS IN GAINING ACCESS THROUGH RGF CHECK POINTS. RGF CLAIMED THAT THEY WERE NOT INFORMED ABOUT THE MISSION. TEAM F CONDUCTED PATROL ALONG NYACYONGO, GABIRO, NYAGATARE. BYUBAT A COY CONDUCTED FOOT PATROLS FROM TUMBA (A9412) TO RULINDO (A9110) AND NYAMUGALI (A8522) TO NEMBA (A8427). B COY CARRIED OUT PATROLS FROM BWISIGE (B1727), MUHERO (B1628), GINUKE (B1629), KAYONZA (B1629), GASHAHI (B1731), KUMANA (B1831) AND NYAMUGALA (B1729). OWN EOD TEAM DEMOLISHED FOLLOWING AMMUNITION WHICH WERE FOUND AT NGARAMA:

- (1) 22 X HE FRAGMENTATION GRENADE
- (2) 4 X ANTI PERSONNEL MINE

C COY CONDUCTED FOOT PATROL FROM KIDAKO TO KAGOGO. COMMANDING OFFICER OF BYUBAT CONDUCTED PATROL TO KINIGI, RUGARAMA, KIDAKO AND KINIHIRA. FORCE ENGR COMPANY PROVIDED SECURITY AT NGONDORRE.

D. MILOH. CONDUCTED RECCE PATROL AT CYONDO AND RWAMANGANA. C 101 WILL STAY TEMPORARILY AT THE CYONDO CHURCH. THE DEPLOYMENT WILL BE EFFECTIVE AT CYONDO ON 061400 MAR 94. THE TEAM WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE RPF BATTALION COMMANDER AT CYONDO.

(1) RGF SECTOR. TEAM 602 CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN KIBUNGU, RISUMO, SAIKE, GASHIRONIMBA, TENDAMA, KANAZE, KIGALO AND RWAMANGANA. NO INCIDENT REPORTED.

(2) RPF SECTOR. TEAM 603 CONDUCTED PATROL IN RPF AREA WITH TEAM 503 TO MONITOR POSSIBLE RPF MOVEMENT. NO MOVEMENT OF RPF WAS OBSERVED.

(3) SOUTHERN SECTOR. TEAM 705 VISITED NUMBER OF REFUGEE CAMPS AT BUTARE. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT. GENDARMERIE AND RGF CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN BUTARE.

5. KIGALI SECTOR. SECTOR KIGALI CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PATROL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA (KWSA). CONDUCTED FIVE CHECK POINT DUTIES IN VARIOUS PLACES IN THE TOWN. TWO APCs WERE EMPLOYED FOR THE SECURITY OF THE CND COMPLEX. PROVIDED 9 UNMO ESCORTS, FIVE FOR RPF, TWO FOR GENDARMERIE, ONE FOR RGF AND ONE FOR UNAMIR. PROVIDED FIVE ARMED ESCORTS, ONE FOR PRIME MINISTER, ONE FOR DESIGNATED PRIME MINISTER, ONE FOR SRSG AND TWO FOR RPF PERSONNEL. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RPF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE, FORCE HQ, SECTOR HQ AND KIGALI AIRPORT. DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED THE PROTECTION OF THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT, FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS AND SRSG.

5. UNCIVPOL. THE GENERAL SITUATION IS REPORTED TO BE CALM. ON 061745 MAR 94 INFORMATION RECEIVED REGARDING A SUSPECT PERSON ENTERED AT CND COMPLEX. THE UNKNOWN PERSON WAS IN THE POSSESSION OF MOTOROLA HANDSET. CIVPOL WENT ON INVESTIGATION TOGETHER WITH LOCAL GENDARMERIE OF KICUKIRO. THE SUSPECTED WAS ARRESTED AND TAKEN TO THE GENDARMERIE OF REMERA. CIVPOL IS INVESTIGATING.

8. LOGISTICS. DISTRIBUTION OF VEHICLES AND RADIOS IS NOT YET COMPLETED. CRITICAL LACK OF VEHICLES, COMMUNICATION AND OFFICE ASSETS. THE LOGISTICS AND ENGINEER COYS EQUIPMENTS/VEHICLES NEEDS ARE PENDING.
