SITREP COVERING PERIOD 100600 JUNE TO 101800Z JUNE 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE DAY WAS RELATIVELY QUITE. HOSTILITY AMONG THE TWO FACTIONS OBSERVED TO BE LESS DURING THE PERIOD IN KIGALI. HOWEVER FIGHTING WAS REPORTED BETWEEN RGF AND RPF AT GATSATA IN KIGALI. THERE WERE NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITIONS OF THE WARRING FACTIONS IN THE CITY AND IN THE SOUTH AND NORTH IN THE COUNTRY. ALSO NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE BATTLE SCENARIO IN THE SOUTH AND AS WELL IN THE NORTH. ARMED CIVILIAN/MILITIA AND GENDARMERIE WERE OBSERVED TO BE MANNING ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS. INFUX OF DISPLACED PERSONS IN THE SOUTH CONTINUES. DFC HELD A MEETING WITH THE CHIEF OF STAFF, RGF AT HOTEL DIPLOMAT THIS AFTERNOON. UNAMIR FOOD CONVOY HAVE ARRIVED KIGALI AT 1600 HRS. MR FLATCHER OF HAC RETURNED FROM MULINDI AFTER ATTENDING A MEETING WITH HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES AND OTHER NGOs WORKING IN THE NORTH OF RWANDA.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: NOTHING TO REPORT.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO SQUEEZE THE RGF POSITIONS LEFT IN THE CITY THROUGH CONSTANT PRESSURE BY ARTY/MORTAR SHELLS. THEY HAVE SURROUNDED RGF POSITIONS AT NYAMIRAMBO AND NAKABANDA. NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITION OBSERVED IN THE NORTH. CONSOLIDATING AND REINFORCEMENT CONTINUED AROUND KABGAYE, RUHUNGO AND NYANZA. ABOUT 5000 RECRUITS WERE SEEN UNDERGOING TRAINING IN GENERAL AREA GABIRO.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUE TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS IN NYAMIRAMBO, KYCHIKIRU AND KIMIHURURA. INFORMATION REVEALED THAT AFTER FIERCE BATTLE, RGF HAVE RECAPTURED GATSATA AND RPF SUSTAINED A LOT OF CASUALTIES. THEY CONTINUED TO CONSOLIDATE AND REINFORCE THEIR POSITIONS AROUND GITARAMA AND RUHENGURI.

C. MILITIA. STILL MANNING SOME CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS IN THE CITY.

4. ONG MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. STAFF BRIEFING WAS CONDUCTED BY THE DFC AT 0700 HRS. DFC HELD A MEETING WITH THE CHIEF OF STAFF OF RGF THIS AFTERNOON AT HOTEL DIPLOMAT. THEY DISCUSSED VARIOUS ISSUES INCLUDING TWO MAJOR ISSUES ONE REGARDING RESUMPTION OF UN FLIGHTS IN KIA AND THE OTHER ON TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS. AFTER SELECTING A NEW RGF DROP OFF POINT THE OPERATION ON TRANSFERRING DISPLACED PERSONS WILL HOPEFULLY RESTART ON 12 JUNE 94. COS RGF ALSO GAVE A PRESS BRIEFING. CHIEF OPERATIONS OFFICER WENT TO KABALE TO COORDINATE THE

HELICOPTER FLIGHTS FROM KABALE TO KAMPALA. HE RETURNED TO KIGALI IN THE AFTERNOON. DFC HELD A DAREAR WITH GHANIAN TROOPS LOCATED AT KIA.

B. INOMUR. AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM. ROUTINE PATROL WERE CARRIED OUT IN AOR. 18 DIFFERENT HUMANITARIAN RELIEF AGENCIES CROSSED THE BORDER THROUGH KATUNA TO RWANDA WITH HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS. A TOTAL OF 45 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER AT KATUNA, KASHEKYE, KYANIKA AND MERAMA HILLS TO RWANDA WITH 419 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 230 REFUGEES. 49 VEHICLES CROSSED INTO UGANDA WITH 197 PASSENGERS. APPROXIMATELY 950 RWANDESE CROSSED THE BORDER AT KYANIKA TO WORK AND MARKETING AND RETURNED THE SAME DAY. WITH THE ARRIVAL OF ANOTHER HELICOPTER FROM NAIROBI NOW THREE HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL.

C. BYURAT. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. PROVIDED ESCORTS FOR HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES AND OTHER DUTIES.

D. TUM PLATOON (+). AREA OF OPERATION RELATIVELY CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MILLE COLLINS HOTEL, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES WITH APCs.

E. MILOB. TWO MILOB TEAMS LED ESCORTED THE LOGISTICS CONVOY FROM KABALE TO KIGALI. MILOBs ESCORTED ICRC OFFICIALS TO TWO REFUGEE CENTERS IN KIGALI. ANOTHER TEAM ESCORTED THE OFFICIALS OF MSF TO ST MICHELLE ORPHANAGE IN KIGALI. TWO MILOB TEAMS WERE DETAILED FOR ONE WEEK MONITORING DUTIES AT ST FAMILLE AND RED CROSS HOSPITAL.

5. UNCIWPOL. 15 ARE STILL IN NAIROBI.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. PATROL WAS CONDUCTED AT ST PAUL AND ST MICHEL ORPHANAGE IN KIGALI. THE SITUATION OBSERVED TO BE GOOD. MSF CONDUCTED THREE SURGICAL OPERATIONS AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ONE TEAM WILL MOVE TO THE HOSPITAL TO STAY PERMANENTLY IN THE HOSPITAL. WFP CONVOY CAME FROM UGANDA WITH 15 TONS OF HEB AND 5000 LTRS OF FUEL. THEY ALSO BROUGHT 7200 LTRS OF FUEL AND RATIONS FOR UNAMIR. 25000 MEASLE VACCINES AND 25000 TETANUS VACCINES WERE ALSO BROUGHT FROM UGANDA. AN IMMUNIZATION CAMPAIGN WILL BE ORGANIZED IN THE REFUGEE CAMPS UNDER UNAMIR CONTROL VERY SOON. AHT/HAC WENT TO MULINDI FOR A MEETING WITH THE RPF REPRESENTATIVE AND OTHER NGOs ON HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. ICRC TREATED 8 PATIENTS. MEDICAL AID WAS GIVEN TO 2158 PEOPLE IN THE STADIUM OF CYANGUGU PREFECTURE AND 3051 PEOPLE AT NYARUSHISHI CAMP. IN KIRAMBO FOODS WERE DISTRIBUTED AMONGST 1052 PEOPLE. FOOD CONSISTS OF 1.5 TON MAIZE FLOUR, 1.5 TON MAIZE AND 1 TON BEANS. ALSO DELIVERED 10 TONS OF FOOD IN BYUMBA PREFECTURE TO 8300 PEOPLE. FOOD DISTRIBUTIONS WERE ALSO CARRIED OUT AT THE MAMA CHRISTINE ORPHANAGE IN GISENYI. THEY HAVE DISTRIBUTED 100 KG BEANS, 90 KG RICE, 100 KG POTATOES AND 80 LTRS OIL. EVACUATION
