SITREP COVERING PERIOD 100600Z JULY TO 101800Z JULY 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS VERY CALM WITHIN KIGALI CITY WITHIN THE PERIOD. MANY LOCALS WERE OBSERVED AND REPORTED TO BE MOVING INTO KIGALI CITY FROM THE REFUGEE CAMPS IN RPF HELD AREAS OUTSIDE THE CITY. FIGHTING IS REPORTED TO BE CONTINUING IN THE NORTH WEST AS RPF SOLDIERS CLOSE IN ON RUHENGERI. UNAMIR LIAISON TEAM IN GOMA REPORTED THAT HEAVY FIGHTING IS GOING ON BETWEEN THE RPF AND RGF IN THE GENERAL AREA OF NYABARONGO RIVER. RGF TROOPS AND SOME MILITIA ARE REPORTED TO BE MOVING NORTH FROM THE AREA OF GIKONGORO TO REINFORCE RGF UNITS AROUND RUHENGERI. THE LATEST FIGHTING HAS RESULTED IN ABOUT 800,000 PEOPLE FLEEING TOWARDS GISENYI AND GOMA. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES HAVE BEEN REPORTED IN THE SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. RPF CONTINUED TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS IN THEIR CONTROLLED AREAS. THE FRENCH FORCES CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE WITHIN THE FRENCH HPZ. THE SRSG VISITED MULINDI TODAY WHERE HE MET THE CHAIRMAN OF THE RPF. THE FC LEFT THIS MORNING FOR ENTEBBE. 2 MILOB TEAMS ARRIVED FROM ENTEBBE TODAY BY AIR.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE SRSG THIS MORNING LEFT FOR MULINDI TO MEET THE CHAIRMAN OF THE RPF. HE DISCUSSED THE SPEEDY PROGRESS TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A CEASE FIRE.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO CONTROL KIGALI CITY AND MUCH OF THE NORTH, SOUTH AND WEST OF THE COUNTRY. THEIR ADVANCE AND ACTIVITIES TOWARDS THE NORTHWEST/WEST OF THE COUNTRY CONTINUED. HEAVY FIGHTING IS REPORTED IN THE AREA OF THE NYABARONGO RIVER NEAR RUHENGERI.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO CONSOLIDATE THEIR POSITIONS IN THEIR CONTROLLED AREAS. REPORTED BE MAKING ATTEMPTS TO HALT RPF ADVANCE TOWARDS RUHENGERI. RGF AND MILITIA ARE REPORTED TO BE MOVING NORTH FROM THE SOUTH TO REINFORCE RGF UNITS IN RUHENGERI.

C. MILITIA. THEIR ACTIVITIES REMAIN CONCENTRATED WITHIN THE RGF CONTROLLED AREAS. THEY CONTINUE TO BE HOSTILE TO UNAMIR PERSONNEL. THEY ARE ALSO REPORTED TO BE MOVING NORTH TO ASSIST RGF IN THE FIGHT AROUND RUHENGERI.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC HELD STAFF BRIEF AT 0800 HRS BEFORE LEAVING FOR ENTEBBE. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. A LIAISON TEAM FROM THE FRENCH COALITION WILL ARRIVE KIGALI TOMORROW TO ESTABLISH A LIAISON OFFICE WITH UNAMIR HQ.

B. UNOMUR. AREA OF OPERATION WAS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE

PATROLS WITHIN THE AREA. BORDER CROSSING - FROM UGANDA TO RWANDA, 73 VEHs WITH 574 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 167 REFUGEES. FROM RWANDA TO UGANDA, 63 VEHs WITH 286 PASSENGERS. ALL THREE HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL. NGOs CONTINUED TO CROSS INTO RWANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.

C. GHANBATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS TO SENIOR OFFICERS AND HUMANITARIAN AID CONVOYS. PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE 6 DISPLACED PERSONS.

D. MILOB. THE CMO ACCOMPANIED THE SRSG TO MULINDI TO MEET WITH THE RPF CHAIRMAN. PREPARATION AND PLANNING FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE CITY. MANY CIVILIANS WERE OBSERVED TO BE MOVING INTO THE CITY TO OCCUPY THE PREMISES THEY VACATED DURING THE WAR. MILOB TRAMS ESCORTED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE CONVOYS WITHIN THE CITY DURING THE PERIOD. THE RPF SECTOR MILOBS WILL RESUME ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR SECTOR WITH EFFECT FROM TOMORROW.

5. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN AID TO DISPLACED PEOPLE WITHIN HPZ. CONTINUED TO DISARM MILITIA LOCATED WITHIN THEIR CONTROLLED AREAS.

6. UNCTYROL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.

7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. MANY LOCALS WERE OBSERVED TO HAVE RETURNED TO THEIR HOUSES WITHIN KIGALI CITY. LIAISON HAS BEEN MADE WITH THE RPF ON THIS ISSUE TO ENSURE A SMOOTH AND ORDERLY RETURN OF THE PEOPLE TO THEIR HOMES IN THE CITY.
