

SITREP COVERING PERIOD 141801Z JULY TO 151800Z JULY 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINED CALM IN KIGALI CITY. CIVILIANS CONTINUED TO RETURN TO THE CITY DURING THE PERIOD. TENSION CONTINUED TO RISE IN GISENYI AS RPF ARE REPORTEDLY CONTINUING THEIR ADVANCE TOWARDS THE TOWN. OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY REMAINED CALM. THE FRENCH ARE REPORTED TO HAVE CONTINUED TO ASSIST IN HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES TO THE HIGH INFUX OF DISPLACED PEOPLE ARRIVING GISENYI AND GOMA FROM RUHENGRI. FC HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH THE INTERIM PRIME MINISTER, MR FAUSTIN THAGWIRAMUNGU. CONTINUED TO ASSIST IN MOVEMENT OF DISPLACED PEOPLE FROM BYUMBA TO KIGALI. TOTAL NUMBER OF PEOPLE WHO WERE TRANSFERRED TODAY TO KIGALI WAS 831. PLANNING AND PREPARATION FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED TODAY.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE INTERIM PRIME MINISTER MR FAUSTIN THAGWIRAMUNGU MET FORCE COMMANDER TODAY. THEY DISCUSSED ABOUT THE CURRENT POLITICAL AND MILITARY SITUATION IN RHANDA. RPF IS LIKELY TO ANNOUNCE UNILATERAL CEASE FIRE BY TOMORROW.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED THEIR ADVANCE TOWARDS GISENYI CAUSING MORE PANIC TO THE GENERAL POPULATION IN THE AREA. HOWEVER THEY HAVE STOPPED THEIR ADVANCE IN GENERAL AREA KORA WHICH IS 25 KMs EAST OF GISENYI. THEY CONTINUED TO ASSIST CIVILIANS RETURNING TO SETTLE IN KIGALI CITY. NO CHANGE IN SITUATION HAS BEEN REPORTED FROM THE SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. REPORTS INDICATE MASSIVE RECRUITMENT IN REFUGEE CAMPS AND MANY TRAINING CAMPS ARE BEING ESTABLISHED IN THEIR AREAS. THEY CONTINUED TO COOPERATE WITH UNAMIR FORCES IN MOVEMENT OF DISPLACED PEOPLE BACK TO KIGALI.

B. RGE. RGE ARE REPORTED TO HAVE RETREATED TO GISENYI AND OTHERS CROSSING THE BORDER TO GOMA IN ZAIRE. THE ZAIRIAN AUTHORITIES ARE REPORTED TO HAVE TRIED TO RETRIEVE WEAPONS AND GRENADES FROM THE RETREATING SOLDIERS AND INTERHAMWE. THIS EXERCISE HAS FAILED DUE TO LARGE NUMBERS OF RGE SOLDIERS CROSSING THE BORDER INTO GOMA, ZAIRE. THEIR MORALE AND FIGHTING SPIRIT HAS GONE DOWN.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ARE ALSO REPORTED TO BE MOVING TOWARDS GISENYI AND OTHERS CROSSING THE BORDER TO GOMA.

4. GEN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. FC'S STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED AT 0800 HRS. HE HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH THE INTERIM PRIME MINISTER, MR FAUSTIN THAGWIRAMUNGU THIS MORNING. THEY DISCUSSED

ISSUES RELATED TO THE CURRENT POLITICAL AND MILITARY SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY. PLANNING AND PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPENDED UNAMIR FORCES CONTINUED DURING THE PERIOD. GHAMBATT CONTINUED TRAINING ON APCs.

B. UKURURU. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE AREA. DETAILS OF BORDER CROSSING BETWEEN UGANDA AND RWANDA WERE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) UGANDA TO RWANDA

(A) VEHs	-	64

18 HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES CROSSED INTO RWANDA WITH A TOTAL NUMBER OF 59 VEHs WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS. THREE HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL.

C. GHAMBATT. CONTINUED TO TRAIN ON APCs. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, FORCE HQ, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE PROTECTION TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT AMAHORO STADIUM, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS TO COVER MOVEMENT OF THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE.

D. MILOR. PROVIDED ARMED ESCORT AND MONITORING TEAMS TO UN AND HUMANITARIAN AID AGENCIES. PROVIDED TEAMS FOR:

- (1) ESCORT OF ONE TRUCK FROM KIGITUMBA TO KIGALI.
- (2) ESCORT FOR MSF TO THE FRENCH SCHOOL ORPHANAGE AND SOME MEDICINE FROM KING FAISAL HOSPITAL TO ST MICHEL CHURCH.
- (3) ESCORTED HAC TEAM AND VISITED CENTRAL HOSPITAL, KIGALI PREFECTURE AND ICRC HOSPITAL.
- (4) ESCORTED CHO FROM KIGALI TO GATUNA AND BACK.

E. FRENCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE WITHIN THE HPZ. HIGH INFLUX OF DISPLACED PEOPLE CONTINUE TO MOVE AND SEEK REFUGEE IN THEIR HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE.

REMAINED VIGILANT WITHIN THEIR AREA AS RPF ARE REPORTEDLY CONTINUING THEIR ADVANCE TOWARDS GISENYI. NUMBER OF DISPLACED PEOPLE ARRIVING IN THEIR PROTECTED ZONE IS REACHING VERY ALARMING AND REQUIRE MORE HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS.

6. UNGLYPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI.

7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. DURING THE PAST 24 HRS THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES WERE UNDERTAKEN:

A. DISPLACED PEOPLE

(1) UNAMIR ASSISTED IN TRANSPORTATION OF 831 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM A CAMP IN BYUMBA TO KIGALI IN COOPERATION WITH RPF. THIS EXERCISE IS PLANNED TO CONTINUE TOMORROW.

B. HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

(1) UNICEF DELIVERED SOME HEB AND HIGH ENERGY MILK TO THE SISTERS OF CHARITY.

(2) PSF DELIVERED MEDICAL SUPPLIES TO THE SISTERS OF CHARITY.

(3) MEDICINES DU MONDE PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE ORPHANS AT SISTERS OF CHARITY.

C. MISCELLANEOUS MEETING BETWEEN MBF, ICRG, SPECIAL ENVOY OF THE AUSTRIAN GOVERNMENT AND THE RPF TOOK PLACE AT THE KIGALI PREFECTURE CONCERNING THE REACTIVATION OF THE KIGALI WATER SYSTEM.
