If you or Buenos Aires can obtain any confirmation of it we should be very grateful. Since this is Canadian information we are not in a position to hand it over to the Americans. We understand that the Canadians are reluctant to do so because the Americans have refused them information on their recent inspection of Dimons; I have suggested to the Canadian High Commission here that this is perhaps short-sighted.
