SUBJECT: PREMIER ZHAO'S STATEMENT ON HON-PROLIFERATION
PUBLISHED IN BEIJING

1. (U) JANUARY 12 PEOPLE'S DAILY, IN ARTICLE QUOTING PREMIER ZHAO'S TOAST AT PRESIDENT'S WELCOHING BANQUET, CONTAINED THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH ON CHINESE NUCLEAR POLICY (PARAGRAPH IS ALSO CONTAINED IN 12 JANUARY XIMHUA RELEASE):

"CHINA HAS ALWAYS OPPOSED THE ARMS RACE, PARTICULARLY THE NUCLEAR ARMS RACE, AND STANDS FOR THE COMPLETE PROHIBITION AND THOROUGH DESTRUCTION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS. WE HAVE LONG DECLARED THAT CHINA WILL NEVER BE THE FIRST TO USE NUCLEAR WEAPONS. WE ARE CRITICAL OF THE DISCRIMINATORY TREATY ON THE NON-PROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS, BUT WE DO NOT ADVOCATE OR ENCOURAGE NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION. WE DO NOT ENGAGE IN NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION. WE DO NOT ENGAGE IN NUCLEAR DEVELOP NUCLEAR WEAPONS. WE ACTIVELY SUPPORT ALL PROPOSALS THAT ARE TRULY HELPFUL TO REALIZING NUCLEAR DISARMAMENT, TERMINATING THE NUCLEAR ARMS RACE AND ELIMINATING THE THREAT OF NUCLEAR WAR."

(C) THE PASSAGE CITED ABOVE CONTAINS SEVERAL NEW, SIGNIFICANT ELEMENTS. CHINESE NON-PROLIFERATION POLICY HAS, OVER THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS, BEEN GIVEN SIMPLY AS THE BEGINNING-TO-MIDDLE PARTS OF THE PREMIER SISTATEMENT, I.E., A DENIAL OF FIRST USE OF NUCLEAR WEAPORRY AN ATTITUDE CRITICAL OF THE HUCLEAR HOX-PROLIFERATION TREATY, BUT A POSITION MEITHER TO ADVOCATE NOR TO ENCOURAGE NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION. THE PREMIER'S STATEMENT GOES CONSIDERABLY BEYOND THE TRADI-. TICHAL FORMULATION OF THE POLICY, CLARIFYING NOT ONLY THAT CHINA HEITHER ADVOCATES NOR ENCOURAGES PROLIFERA-THE PREHIER'S STATEMENT THAT CHINA WILL HEITHER ENGAGE IN NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION NOR ASSIST ANY OTHER NATION TO OBTAIN NUCLEAR WEAPONS THUS SOLIDIFIES THE REANING OF THE EARLIER, LESS-DEFINITE PHRASE. IT SEEMS TO US TO BE AN ACTIVE STATEMENT OF NON-PROLIFERATION FOLIGY BY CHINA, AND IS, TO OUR KNOWLEDGE, THE FIRST TIME A CHINESE LEADER HAS HADE THE POLICY SO CLEAR IN PUBLIC FORUM.

3. (G) THE FINAL SENTENCE, ON SUPPORT OF PROPOSALS THAT WILL LEAD TO DISARHAMENT AND REDUCE THE DANGERS OF MUCLEAR WAR, SEEMS NOT TO BE A NEW CHINESE POSITION. WE HAVE NOT HEARD IT STATED SO VERY OFTEN, HOWEVER, IN JUXTAPOSITION WITH THE POSITION OF CRITICISM TOWARD THE MPT AND HON-ADVOCACY OF THE NON-PROLIFERATION.

LEAST A POSITIVE CLARIFICATION OF CHINA'S NON-PROLIFERATION POLICY, BUT ALSO MAY BE A REASONED SYNTHESIS OF CHINESE OVERALL POLICY TOWARD NON-PROLIFERATION AND DISARMAMENT. IF SO, THE NEW STATEMENT IS CONSISTENT WITH A NUMBER OF OTHER EVOLUTIONARY CHANGES IN CHINA'S HUCLEAR POLICIES OVER THE RECENT PAST, INCLUDING THE DECISION IN THE LATTER HALF OF 1983 AT LAST TO JOIN THE IAEA.
