MEMORANDUM TO THE OFFICER IN CHARGE  
SUBJECT: SEIDMAN, Adolf

Reference is made to basic communication, letter from Counter Intelligence Corps 430th CIC Det. USFA, Land Salzburg Section, APC 241, dated 21 October 1946, subject same as above.

An investigation conducted by this office revealed the following information:

- a. Records at the Wehrungsamt, Arbeitsamt (Labor Office), and German Police failed to indicate the presence of one Coerst JAARI.
- b. Records at the International Military Tribunal in Nuremberg (IMT/04C) and a personal interview with Major Thomas Koppke of the CIC in the IMT revealed the following:

One JAARI, Sender was employed in the IMT as an interpreter and assistant to Col. A. M. ... during his stay in Nurnberg ... contact with Franz von SCHLACK at various occasions, and in the capacity in which JAARI was employed could be the ... JAARI left Nurnberg ... his address in the United States is:

Subject was born in Finland around 1900, 5' tall, blue eyes, half bald, black hair, deep voice, extremely fair complexion, heavy drinker. Subject speaks Finnish, Swedish, Danish, German, French and English. Subject
