1. At a meeting on 11 December, 1960, [] made certain disclosures to [] which are interesting in the light of [] and []

2. During a discussion of the book Eichmann, Technician of Death by Phillip Paueth de PANAY [] brought up the name of the Dr. Rudolnh-KASTNER, who is prominently mentioned in the book. [] reacted strongly. He said he had received from the Nazis in West Germany 160 pages of documentation on KASTNER showing exactly how the latter was working with the Nazis at the time he was letting Jews out of Hungary. [] said he is organizing this documentation from the Nazis into a form which will be used to counter the bad effects of the facts that will come out of the trial of EICHMANN in Israel. [] said that this idea came from his Nazi friends in the West German government who are afraid of the things that will come out of the EICHMANN trial next spring.

3. [] then stated that he has some 50 pages of EICHMANN's memoirs, which [] resumes are from the said West German sources. He chuckled and said "You know very well I didn't get it from the Jews." [] said that the Jews were presently negotiating with the Soviet government to obtain documentation on EICHMANN which the Soviets have in their possession. The Soviets are willing to give this EICHMANN data to the Israelis, according to [] on the condition the Israelis use it to undermine the Adenauer government. [] said he had also received this information from Nazi friends in West Germany.

4. [] gave [] orally the contents of a very recent letter from the Israeli General Yigael YADIN to [] General YADIN is now at the Institute of Strategic Studies in England. He wrote that he is doing his doctorate thesis on "The Afro-Asian Bloc in the United Nations". He said this would enable him to do research on the political setup of the Arab League and the neutral countries in the Afro-Asian group. YADIN added that he intended to visit Geneva soon. [] wrote all this down. He explained that President Nasser had shown keen personal interest in item [] had furnished previously to General YADIN because this Israeli general was a friend of Nasser. "Could you please try to get possession of this letter for just one hour," [] pleaded, "so I can photocopy it". It would please Nasser very much to see a letter written by his old friend. Please do everything you can to get it. [] assumes that [] is being able to forward such a letter would help show that the old fox is on the ball in Geneva.

Comment: This lends credence to the possibility that [] is involved in West Germany. While it does not add any evidence that [] could be under Israeli control, it does indicate he has information which would be of interest to the [] services. [] are not aware of Headquarters interest in the EICHMANN trial. [] relations and how much for this is common knowledge.
