Dear Mr. Beddie,

In answer to your letter I have to inform you that the ITS does not hold any information pertaining to Adolf EICHMANN, born Solingen, March 19, 1906.

This is quite normal as the ITS, as you know, only holds records pertaining to the victims of the national socialist persecution.

On the other hand, some documents are to be found in ITS' archives concerning the deportation of Jews from Western Germany during the years 1942 - 1943 signed by Eichmann by command of higher Authority ("im Auftrag"). Most of these documents have been acquired by IRO in February 1949 from the Intelligence Library, Herford, Control Commission Germany, British Element.
