

Re: Begleiter v. Dept. of Defense, et al.

Dear Mr. Mach:

The Department of Defense has authorized me to convey the following regarding your client's Freedom of Information Act request. After searches of numerous components of the Department of Defense both within and outside of the Air Force, the Department of Defense has located several hundred images that are responsive to Mr. Begleiter's request. These images are in addition to the 361 images previously provided to Mr. Begleiter. The Department of Defense intends to provide these images to your client subject to redaction or withholding of any information that would "constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). The Department of Defense intends to provide 92 images to Mr. Begleiter early next week and to provide the remainder of responsive images at the end of next week or the beginning of the following week. The Department of Defense and/or its components will communicate to Mr. Begleiter which components have located documents and which components have searched and returned a no records response.
