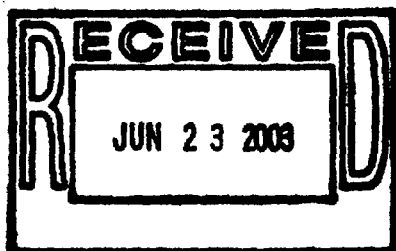

**Dear Ms. Sloca and Ms. Vogt:**

**Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, I am requesting access to the following information:**

- **Copies of all telephone and cell phone records of Michael Rossetti, counselor to Interior Secretary Gale Norton, from the date he joined the Department of the Interior through April 30, 2003. These records should list the phone numbers of all incoming and outgoing calls made on Mr. Rossetti's office phone and government-paid cell phone, and the duration of each call.**
- **Copies of all emails that Mr. Rossetti sent or received at his Department of the Interior email address ([michael\\_rossetti@ios.doi.gov](mailto:michael_rossetti@ios.doi.gov)) between the date he joined the department and April 30, 2003.**
- **Copies of any appointment calendar that Mr. Rossetti kept between the date he joined the Department of the Interior and April 30, 2003. This would include any appointment calendar he kept on a personal digital assistant.**

If there are any fees for searching for or copying the records I have requested, please inform me before you fill the request.

As you know, the Act permits you to reduce or waive the fees when the release of the information is considered as "primarily benefiting the public." I believe that this request fits that category and I therefore ask that you waive any fees. I also ask that this request be expedited because it involves a timely matter of interest to the general public in Western New York.

If all or part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) you think justifies your refusal to release the information and inform me of your agency's administrative appeal procedures available under the law.

I would appreciate your handling this request as quickly as possible, and I look forward to hearing from you within 10 working days, as the law stipulates.
