



0733 CNO Arrived

7 0735 Kennedy reported in process of boarding Marucla

- 0759 CNO, left for flag plot to read-out the boarding
- O832 CNO, VCNO, ADM Griffin, ADM Sylvester, ADM Radom and others arrived and went into conference.
- O835 CAPT Kidd requested information from CDR Walker regarding a sub flushing so he could take the information into CNO for the joint chiefs meeting.
- 0836 C-18 sub on surface about 0825, CAPT Kidd said.
- O838 At CAPT Kidd's request, CAPT Davis said they don't know if it is the same sub or not which surfaced last evening. He said CINCLANTELT had called in the report and they are checking it out.
- Received a message stating the boarding party boarded at 0605 at 26-16N 74-24W with no difficulty.
- 0855 CNO departed for JCS conference.
- O905 CAPT Kidd called ADM Lowrence to tell him that CNO had taken note of the tremendous job his people were doing in coming up with information on the merchants ships. He asked if there was an objection to a kudos for the job that particular section was doing.
- CAP T Kidd gave the names of the commanders of Marucla boarding ships: COMDESDIV 102, CAPT S.H. Moore in DD850; commanded by CDR N. Mikhalevsky; COMDESDIV 21 CAPT C.E. Pond in DD753 J.R. Pierce, commanded by CDR J.W. Foust. (NOTE: Not sure if 21 in Pierce and Foust believed to have recently relieved CDR A.V. Lorentson.)
- O925 CAPT Kidd requested of officer who came in to discuss the proposed Kudos to ADM Lowmence's group that a list of ships be drawn up which are under charter to the Bloc engaged in the Cuban trake.
- O940 CAPT Kidd ordered a log of all persons entering Flag Plot add IP. He said that the president was objecting to the amount of information the press was getting, particularly ships' positions, He said to direct that everyone be logged who are not Navy or "in the family." The conversation was with COL Malin.
- O941 Gall for CAPT Kidd with the word that plot is not sure that a sub surfaced this morning,
- 0948 Mr. Sylvester and ALM McCain arrived to see ADM Rickets.

- O955 CAPT Kidd explained to CAPT Thomas that a submarine can be considered "flushed" when surveillance is sufficiently intense to cause a submarine to stay down until he is forced to come up for air.
- 1008 VCNO left
- 1010 CAPT Kidd received a call and asked me to note the names Enthoven and Brown. (NOTE: A few minutes later he called someone and asked if Enthoven and Hitch had arrived.)
- 1015 VCNO returned
- Passed following message to CNO at JCS: Boarding party off Marucla and returning to Kennedy. Marucla on her way.
- CNO returned. (NOTE: During my absence, CNO told CAPT Kidd that when Time-Life writes up the operation to ask them to include the dependent story. CAPT Kidd passed this the ADM McCain and Capt Thomas.)
- 1355 CNO departed for JCS meeting
- 1400 CAPT Kidd called CAPT Thomas regarding a possible human interest story.
- ADM McCain left with pictures of the Bucharest which he was going to try to get Mr. Sylvester to Clear for release. CAPT Kidd told him about the human interest story which involved a delay in sailing because of a baby delivery.
- CAPT Riera was in concerning plans to board the Groznyy and referred to CINCLANT/COM2FLT policy which was in conflict. CAPT Kidd took a directive CAPT Riera brought with him into ADM Ricketts.
- NOTE: About 1530, ADM Griffin came out and was concerned about a scandinavian tanker and ordered information on her. CAPT Kidd went to flag plot and got the data.
- NOTE: About 1530, much interest shown concerning the Grosnyy and a new C-18 contact.
- 1555 CAPT Kidd called for the latest information concerning boarding of the Groznyy.
- 1615 Mr. McNamara arrived for a meeting with ADM Griffin
- Nationality of tanker to the south of Cuba requested by CAPT Kidd from I.P.
- 1700 CDR Walker was in with some information requested concerning a slide projection showing the merchant ship picture in the Atlantic.





NO TE:	It developed later that this had some bearing on Mr. McNamara's visit with Mr. Carroll of DIA regarding an automated visual presentation.
1715	CNO returned and immediately went into conference
1945	A new Surfaced submarine reported at 21-31N 69-14W
1808	CNO departed for quarters
2025	SAC reported sighting Grosnyy but the report was not firm.
2130	CNO has arrived at Pentagon
2240 -	CNO arrived at office
2312	CNO departed for quarters.
