SUBJECT: Damage Assessment - Pollard Espionage Case

Disclosure of the fact of intelligence collection targeted against specific non-Soviet Bloc countries poses a risk of harm to the national security. Accordingly, all Department of Defense documents reflecting the fact of such collection should be reviewed to ensure that it is protected from disclosure by a minimum classification level of CONFIDENTIAL-NOT RELEASABLE TO FOREIGN NATIONALS.
