(U) NATIONAL DISTRICT CHIEF PROSECUTOR FRANCISCO DOMINGUEZ BRITO, SPEAKING AT THE SAME CONFERENCE ON THE TOPIC "VIOLENCE AND HUMAN RIGHTS", SAID THAT NOT ONLY THE POLICE IN MANY CASES TURN INTO VIOLENT AND AGGRESSIVE ENTITIES, BUT EVEN JUDICIAL ACTORS SUCH AS JUDGES AND PROSECUTORS EXERCISE THEIR AUTHORITY IN WAYS THAT GENERATE VIOLENCE. WHEN THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM FAILS TO GUARANTEE THE RIGHTS OF VICTIMS, IT GENERATES AN INVISIBLE VIOLENCE HARSHER THAN THAT OF A BILLY CLUB. VIOLENCE OCCURS NOT ONLY WHEN THE POLICE KILL WHEN THEY COULD AVOID IT, BUT ALSO WHEN, BY WORD OR DEED, A WALL IS CREATED BETWEEN THE POOR AND THEIR ACCESS TO JUSTICE.
