NOTE TO THE ATTENTION OF  
THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC

SUBJECT: RWANDA

The current predominant climate in RWANDA is influenced by neighboring countries' position in the conflict.

It can only be stabilized by regional cooperation between the different countries in the zone.

Therefore, our military presence in RWANDA risks lasting until a political solution can be found.

This is why it might be necessary to plan a mission led by Mr. PELLETIER to the countries in the region (KENYA, UGANDA, TANZANIA, BURUNDI, RWANDA) to highlight our support for the opening of regional dialogue that would allow an "African" solution to the conflict. President MUSEVENI and RWANDA have already asked for this.
