SITREP COVERING PERIOD 230600B JAN TO 240600B JAN 94.

- I. GEN SITUATION. APPARENTLY CALM BUT TENSE.
 - A. ON SATURDAY 22 JAN 94 A HOUSE WAS DEHTHOVED IN THE CENTER OF KIGALI (NYAMIRAMED). SUBSEQUENTLY A MEMBER OF THE POLITICAL MILITIA, INTERAHAMME, WAS ARRESTED AND POSSIBLY BEATED BY GENDARMERIE. ON SUNDAY AFTERNOON INTERAHAMME WAS MOBILIZED AS PROTEST AGAINST THIS IMPRISONMENT. AT 17.90 HRS A ROAD BLOCK WAS SET UP AND STONES WERE THROWN TO A KIBAT PTL THAM AND TO A UN HELICOPTER FLYING OVER THE SPOT. GENDARMERIE WAS NOT ABLE TO CONTROL THE CROWD AND FLED FROM THE SPOT. WHEN NIGHT FELT KIBAT LEFT ALSO DUE TO THE PRESSURE OF INTERAHAMME. LOCALS IMPSTLY TUTS!) WERE MOLESTED AND BEATEN. TWO PERSONS WENT TO THE RPF CND COMPOUND AND GOT RPP PROTECTION. THE PIRST ARRIVED WITH A CAR HAVING BROKEN SHIELDS AND THE SECOND HAD A NECKLINDURY.
 - B. THE FOLLOWING SHOOTING INDIDENTS TOOK PLACE IN THE EVENING:
 - (1) AT 23.05 BRS THREE ROUNDS WERE FIRED FROM A WHITE VEHICLE IN THE VICINITY OF THE CND COMPOUND.
 - (2) AT 23.15 HRS SEVERAL ROUNDS MERE FIRED AT 300 M FROM THE CND COMPOUND, RUTHAT PTL WENT OUT TO CHECK AND FOUND ONE PERSON WITH MAJOR INJURIES, HE WAS EVACUATED TO THE UNAMIR FIELD HOSPITAL WHERE HE DISC.
 - (3) AT 23.20 HRS THPFE SHOTS WERE FIRED BY SRSG'S SECURITY PERSONNEL FROM FIRAT. BURGLARS TRIED TO ENTER SRSG'S RESIDENCE.

A. HOS. ON 22 JAN 94 FORCE HO (CHIEF PLANS AND DEPUTY CHIEF OPERATIONS OFFICER) WENT TO RECCE THE CAMPS AT GAKO. BUTARE AND BIGOGWE PROPOSED BY ROF AS INTEGRATED TRAINING CENTERS.

- (1) KIGALI. CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PTG IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE RIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. ESTABLISHED 3 CHECK POINTS AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KWSA. PROVIDED 4 UNMO ESCORTS TO PPF AND 3 TO RGF. ALSO PROVIDED ONE ARMED ESCOPT TO PRIME MINISTER AND 2 TO RPF PERSONNEL. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RPF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, THE PREMATURE, FORCE HO AND SEC HO AND PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE AIRPORT OF KIGALI. DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION FOR THE PRIME MUNISTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AND FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS. AND TO THE RESIDENCE OF SRSG.
- (2) DMZ. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PTL WITHIN CAR. SITUATION IS NORMAL, IN THE AREA.
- MILOB, CONDUCTED ONE ESCERT FOR RPF TO MULINDI AND ONE ESCORT FOR ITALIAN AMBASSADOF FROM GATISVA TO KIGALI.
- UNOMUR. THE SITUATION IN THE UNOMUR AREA IS CALM. D. POLITICAL CAMPAIGN OF THE CA IS ONGDING. ONLY THE POLITICAL GIANTS ARE STILL IN THE RACE. DECAMPAIGNING PRRVALENT BUT ON A SILENT NOTE. ROUTINE BY BEING CONDUCTED. FIFTEEN REPUGEES WITH 1,000 COMS CROSSED THE BORDER AT LUBIRIZI AREA TO RNANDA NEAR THE RPF POSITION AT MRADE. A TOTAL OF THIRTY-FOUR VEHICLES CROSSED THE EORDER AT KATUNA (34 WORLD FOOD PROGRAM TRUCKS, 6 CIVILIAN CARS FROM UGANDA AND 4 CIVILIAN CARS FROM RWANDA: A TOTAL OF 38 PASSENCERS CROSSED THE BORDER WITH THEIR PERSONAL LUGGGAGE. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT WAS FOUND.
