SITREP COVERING PERIOD 110600B JAN TO 120600B JAN 94.

I. GEN SITUATION. CALM. ON 111230 JAN 94 A GRENADE WAS THROWN IN THE CAR OF MR. KATAWANDRA, FORMER MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS, AND EXPLODED. THE MAN HAD MINDE INJURIES. THE INDIDENT HAPPENED NEAR THE GERMAN EMBASSY AT KIUALI CITY. AT 111830 JAN 94 MR KATAWANDRA FOUND AN UNEXPLODED GRENADE IN HIS PROPERTY. THE PATROL TEAM OF SEC KIGALI BEING INFORMED THE GRENADE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY DESTROYED BY BELOIAN EOD TEAM.

A. POLITICAL. NEGOTIATIONS ONGOING IN ORDER TO UNBLOCK THE POLITICAL SITUATION.

III. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. HOS. STAFFING ONDDING ON FMHANCING EXISTING SECURITY. IN RRIEFING WAS ORGANIZED FOR 14 UNMOS FORM NIGARIA THAT ARRIVED IN THE MISSION AREA ON 10 JAN 94. 10 UNMOS FROM EGYPT ARRIVED ON 11 JAN 94. PLANNING SEC ORGANIZED A MEETING AT NGONDORE (0529) BETWEEN RGF AND RFF ON ARMY REGULATIONS.

B. SECTORS.

- (1) <u>KIGALI</u>, CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PTL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AND FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS. PLANNING CONTINUED FOR ECCURIC SUPARING. IN CEREMONIES OVER NEXT FEW DAYS.
- (2) DMZ. CONDUCTED LONG DISTANCE PTL TO GISENY (1712). PROVIDED ESCORT FOR SWISS ENGINEERS SURVEYING THE ROAD AROUND BULIARA. OBSERVED THE MEETING AT NGONDORE (KM 64). RGF TROOPS WERE OBSERVED CONCENTRATING AT KM 61 AT 14.00 HRS. THE TEAM ALSO CAME ACROSS THREE BUSSES WITH RGF TROOPS MOVING TO NGONDORE. ELECTRICITY AT BYWHAA TOWN IS BRRADIC WITH

POWER CUTS OVER LONG PERIODS. PEOPLE ARE CUTTING TREES ALONG THE ROADS FOR USE AS FIRE WOOD. POPULATION OF BYUMBA SEEMS TO BE INCREASING GRADUALDY.

VII. LOGISTICS. OPFRATIONAL SITUATION REMAINS DIFFICULT DUE TO THE LACK OF VEHICLES AND RADIOS. STAFFING ENGOING ON THE OPERATION OF UNLOADING THE SHIPS ARRIVING IN DAR ES SALAAM SOON.

VIII. MISC.

- IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 872. A. PAR. 3(e), A HQS BCARD OF UNQUIRY WAS CONVENED BY SRSG TO INVESTIGATE AND REFORT THE INCIDENT WHICH OCCURRED ON THE NIGHT OF THE 17th NOVEMBER 1993 AT THE SUB PREFECTURE OF KIRAMBO (PREFECTURE RUHENGHERE) WHERE A NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN VARIOUS VILLAGES OF THE SAME SUR PREFECTURE WERE BRUTALLY KILLED AND INJURED.
- ALTHOUGH THE BOARD WAS SUPPOSED TO SUBMIT THE P. PROCEEDINGS BY 31 DEC 33 BUT TILL TODAY THE BOARD COULDN'T EVEN START THE INVESTIGATION. THIS HAPPENED BECAUSE OF TWO REASONS-
 - DELAY IN GETTING THE RGF MEMBERS. THE NAMES OF THE TWO ROP MEMBERS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED BUT ONE OF THEM IS YET TO SHOW UP, THE POF RESPONSE IN THIS REGARD HAS BEEN VERY SLOW
 - OF TVOD BESTDAMF AHT OF TERUÇUSE RETERM A HAM BH 2. BEAR THE EXPENSES ACCOMMODATION, FOOD, ...) OF THE REF MEMBERS DURING THEIR STAY AT KIGALI BUT THE GOVE HAS NOT YET RESPONDED TILL NOW.
- THE BOARD, HOWEVER. IS TRYING ITS BEST TO SORT OUT THE c. ABOVE PROBLEMS AND START THE INVESTIGATION ASAP.
- SRSG HAS MADE A FORMAL COMPLAINT TO THE GOVT AND D. DISAPPROVED THEIR ATTITUDE IN THIS BEGARD.
