SITREP COVERING PERIOD 250600B APR TO 260600B APR 94,

- 1. GEM SITUATION. SITUATION REMAINS TENSE AND PLUID. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN FORWARD EDGE OF BATTLE AREA BETWEEN RGF AND RPF TO THE NORTH AND EAST OF COUNTRY. IN THE CITY, HEAVY EXCHANGE OF ARTY AND MORTAR FIRE OCCURED DURING THE PERIOD. SHELLS LANDED CLOSE TO HOTEL MILLES COLLINS, IN KIMIHIRURA CAMP AND CND COMPLEX. FIVE ROUNDS LANDED CLOSE TO UNAMIR POSITIONS AROUND THE AIRPORT WITH THE ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE BUILDING TAKING ONE DIRECT HIT. ONE ROUND ALSO LANDED CLOSE TO FORCE HQ BUILDING. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN DISPOSITION OF TROOPS IN THE CITY. IT IS BELIEVED THAT RPF TROOPS ADVANCING WEST FROM RWAMAGANA HAVE LINXED UP WITH TROOPS ALREADY IN THE CITY. EXODUS OF REFUGERS FROM CITY HEADING NORTH FROM CITY OBSERVED DURING THE PERIOD. HUMANITARIAN CELL VISITED MULINDI AND HAD DISCUSSIONS WITH RPF ON WHAT HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE CAN BE OFFERED. FC ALSO HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH RGF COS AND PREFECT OF KIGALI.
- 2. <u>POLITICAL ACTIVITIES</u>. STALEMATE CONTINUES, NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT,

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. TROOPS OBSERVED NORTH OF KIGALI AND ON HIGH GROUND OVERLOOKING ROAD KIGALI RUHENGERI. TROOPS FROM BAST BELIEVED TO HAVE LINKED UP WITH TROOPS IN THE CITY. EXCHANGED BIRE WITH RGF TROOPS WITHIN THE CITY. IT WAS OBSERVED DURING THE PERIOD THAT TROOPS WERE CARTING REPUGERS FROM OUTSKIRTS OF KIGALI TO CAMPS 10 KM2 NORTH OF CITY.
- B. RGF. TWO NEW LMG AND ONE MORTAR POSITIONS OBSERVED AROUND THE AIRPORT DURING THE PERIOD. ATTEMPTS TO PLY HELICOPTERS OUT OF AIRPORT ATTRACTED RPF MORTAR FIRE, HOWEVER LIGHT AIRCRAFT AND TWO X HELICOPTERS TOOK OFF IN THE AFTERNOON. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN AREAS UNDER THEIR CONTROL.
- C. MILITIA. STILL IN CONTROL OF CERTAIN PARTS OF THE CITY.
- 4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES READJUSTMENT OF TROOPS TO NEW POSITIONS AND NEW ROLES STILL IN PROGRESS.
 - A. FORCE MG. IMPROVEMENT OF DEFENSES AT FORCE MG IN PROGRESS. PC HELD CONFERENCES WITH COMMANDERS AND PRINCIPAL STAFF OFFICERS AT 250700 AND 252000 APR 94. FC ALSO HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH RGF COS AND PREFECT OF KIGALI ON CROSS EXCHANGE OF REFUGESS FROM RGF/RPF AREAS. TALKS DID NOT YIBLD ANY POSITIVE RESULTS AS COS WAS NOT READY TO TAKE ON THE ARMED MILITIA FOR THIS EXCHANGE TO TAKE PLACE. FC PLANS HOLDING ANOTHER DISCUSSION WITH RPF HIGH COMMAND IN MULINDITODAY. ONE MORTAR ROUND LANDHD CLOSE TO HQ BUILDING CAUSING

MEETING WITH ICRC IN KIGALI REVEALED THAT FOOD BEING DISTRIBUTED TO REFUGEES IS BEING LOOTED BY ARMED MILITIA. SITUATION HAS FORCED ICRC TO SUSPEND DISTRIBUTION, ICRC ALSO REPORTS OF WOUNDED PEOPLE BEING TAKEN OUT OF HOSPITAL BEDS AND EXECUTED BY THE MILITIA.

- B. RPF MOVED SEVERAL THOUSAND REFUGEES FROM THE CND AND AMAHORO STADIUM OVERNIGHT EN ROUTE TO EYUMBA. UNAMIR ASSISTANCE IN THIS DIRECTION WAS REJECTED BY THE RPF.
