SITREP COVERING PERIOD 021800B JUN TO 030500B JUN 94.

- 1. GEN BITUATION. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM OVER THE PERIOD BUT REMAINS TENSE AND UNPREDICTABLE. SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MOR, HMG AND SMALL ARMS FIRE CONTINUED WARRING FACTIONS AROUND THE CND. KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND IN THE CITY CENTER. RPF ADVANCE WESTWARDS IN THE SOUTH PROGRESSING STEADILY. IT IS REPORTED THAT THE RPF HAS TAKEN CONTROL OF KAEGAYE AND THE ICRC CAMP IN KAEGAYE. THEY HAVE ASKED THE ICRC TO MOVE THEIR EXPATRIATE AND LOCAL STAFF AS WELL AS THE OVER 100 WOUNDED SOUTHWARDS FOR PEAR OF REPRISAL SHELLING BY THE RGF. SOME ELEMENTS ALSO REPORTED TO BE HEADING SOUTH TOWARDS BUTARE. THE RPF HAS GIVEN THE GO AHEAD FOR HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS TO BE MOVED INTO RHANDA BY ROAD FROM THE NORTH THROUGH RPF LINES. THE EXODUS OF SOLDIERS AND THEIR FAMILIES, MILITIAMEN AND CIVILIANS TO THE SOUTH CONTINUES. THE TRANSPER OF DISPLACED PERSONS RECOMMENCES TODAY AFTER BOTH SIDES GAVE THEIR ASSURANCES TO COOPERATE FULLY WITH UNAMER ON THE OPERATION.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. PRESIDENT arap MOI OF KENYA IS REPORTED TO HAVE SCHEDULED A REGIONAL MEETING ON RWANDA FOR MONDAY 6 JUNE 94. THE SREG IS STILL IN ETHIOPIA.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. CONTINUE TO PRESURIZE RGF POSITIONS IN THE WEST OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CENTER. REPORTED TO HAVE EXCHANGED HEAVY ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAG FIRE FROM MERIDIEN HOTEL AREA TO KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA AND CITY CENTRE OVERNIGHT. ADVANCE WESTWARDS IN THE SOUTH CONTINUES AFTER CAPTURING KABGAYE. FIGHTING IS REPORTED IN THE GENERAL AREA OF NTONGWE AND EUTAMWE SOUTH OF KIGALI. NOW IN FULL CONTROL OF THE ROAD KIGALI-GITARAMA AT RUNDA.
- B. RGF. RGF CONTINUE TO RETALIATE RPF FIRES FROM KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, AND FROM THE CITY CENTRE TOWARDS CND AND POSITIONS NEAR HOTEL MERIDIEN. EXODUS OF SOLDIERS TO THE SOUTH CONTINUES. INDICATIONS ARE THAT THE TROOPS IN AND AROUND GITARAMA ARE DISORGANINSED AND UNDER NO CONTROL. GENDARMERIE CONTINUE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS IN THE CITY. NO CHANGES REPORTED IN DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH. NOW CONSOLIDATING AROUND GITARAMA AFTER LOSING KAEGAYE TO THE RPF. LOW MORALE AND DESERTION SERIOUSLY AFFECTING THEIR FIGHTING CAPABILITIES.
- C. MILITIA. VERY LITTLE PRESENCE IN KIGALI NOW.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

A. FORCE ED. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. FC HELD NORMAL BRIEFING WITH STAFFS AT 021900 JUN 94 AND DISCUSSED MATTERS RELATED TO THE SECOND CEASE FIRE MEETING AND THE OUTCOME AND RECOMMENCING OF THE TRANSFER OF

DISPLACED PEOPLE TO SECURB AREAS.

- B. UNCOUNT. AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM, NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.
- C. ETURAT. CONTINUED TO FROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PROPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM, CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG THE RUNWAY AT 022200 TO 022300 JUN 94.
- D. THE PLATON (+). CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT HOTEL MERIDIEN, HOTEL MILLES COLLINS AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. OBSERVED EXCHANGES OF HEAVY ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAS FIRE BETWEEN RPF POSITIONS AROUND CND AND HOTEL MERIDIEN AND RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTRE.
 - E. MILOS REORGANIZATION FOR PHASE I DEPLOYMENT CONTINUES. MORE UNMOS ARE RETURNING FROM NAIROBI.
- 5. <u>UNCLYPOL</u>. ALL 15 ARE STILL IN NAIROBI.ARRIVAL OF ADVANCE PARTY OF 3 AWAITED TO COMMENCE STAFFING FOR PHASE 1.
- 6. AUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PROPLE IS TO RESUME: THIS MORNING. ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PROPLE AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND OTHER LOCATIONS CONTINUE. POOD, MEDICINE AND WATER STILL IN SHORT SUPPLY. ICRC TEAM AT KABGAYE PLAN TO MOVE TO BUTARE WITH THEIR PATIENTS TO AVOID RGF RETALIATORY FIRE.
