- I. GEN SITUATION. THE SITUATION REMAINED CALM BUT UNPREDICTABLE. EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN THE WARRING FACTIONS CONTINUED IN VILLAGE URUGWIRO, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. RPF CONTINUED TO TIGHTEN THEIR GRIP ON THE RGF POSITIONS IN AN ATTEMPT TO STRANGLE THE RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE WITHIN KIGALI CITY. THERE WAS NO CHANGE IN MILITIAL ACTIVITIES. NO REPORTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED ON ANY CHANGES IN THE BATTLE SITUATION AND DISPOSITIONS OF BOTH FACTIONS IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH APART FROM SOME FIGHTING AROUND RUNDA ON KIGALI GITARAMA ROAD. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS DID NOT TAKE PLACE TODAY DUE TO CONTINUED FIGHTING IN THE CITY AND THE GENDARMES COMPLAINING THAT THE RGF DROP OFF POINT AT RUNDA WAS NOT SAFE BECAUSE OF FIGHTING BETWEEN RGF AND RPF IN THE AREA. THE DFC PAID A WORKING VISIT TO THE TUNISIAN TROOPS AT HOTEL MERIDIEN.
- POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: MANY AREAS OF THE RGP CONTROLLED AREA OF THE CITY OF KIGALI WERE DECORATED WITH THE FRENCH FLAG, AN INDICATION: OF SUPPORT BY SUPPORTERS OF THE INTEXIM GOVT FOR THE FRENCH HUMANITARIAN SUPPORT INITIATIVE. RTLM CONTINUED TO INCITE THE POPULATION TO RISE AND PIGHT THE ENEMY. THERE ARE REPORTS OF THE INTERIM GOVT NOT BEING TOO HAPPY WITH THE NUMBER OF ENGLISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES CONTRIBUTING TROOPS TO THE EXPANDED UNAMIR.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

- A. RPP: RPF CONTINUED TO EXCHANGE ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAME FIRE AS THEY CONTINUED TO SQUEEZE THE ISOLATED RGF POSITIONS IN URUGWIRO VILLAGE, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER. CONTINUED TO MAKE SOME SLOW PROGRESS IN THE CITY: REPORTED TO BE FIGHTING WITH THE RGF AT RUNDA ON KIGALI GITARAMA ROAD.
- B: RGF: CONTINUED TO RESIST FROM THEIR POSITIONS IN URUGWIRD VILLAGE, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMEO AND THE CITY CENTER. THEIR MORALE: CONTINUES TO RISE AS THEY AWAIT THE FRENCH:
- C: MILITIA. THERE IS NO CHANGE IN THEIR ACTIVITIES.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. A STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED BY FC AT 0700 HRS. THE DFC PAID A VISIT TO HOTEL MERIDIEN TO INSPECT AND CHECK ON THE CONDITION OF TROOPS AND THE DISPLACED PEOPLE. A SCHEDULED MEETING WITH THE COS RGF COULD NOT COME ON:

- B: UNCOUR. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES CONTINUE TO CROSS INTO RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.
- C. GEARRATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ABSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS LOCATED AT THE KIA AND THE STADIUM. OWN MEDICAL STAFF PROVIDED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO 20 DISPLACED PROPLE.
- D. TON PL. CONTINUED TO BE PROVIDE SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN. ALSO PROVIDED HOMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PROPLE AT HOTEL MERIDIEN AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL.
- B. MILOS. PLANNING AND REORGANIZATION CONTINUE. THE POLLONING WERE TASKS PERFORMED DURING THE PERIOD:
 - (1) ONE TEAM MONITORED THE REPUGEE CAMPS AT ST MITCHELL AND RED CROSS HOSPITAL. THE TEAM ALSO ARRANGED, IN CONJUNCTION WITH RGF LIAISON THE EVACUATION OF DISPLACED PERSONS FROM RGF HELD AREAS.
 - (2) TWO TEAMS ESCORTED OFFICIALS OF MSF AND RED CROSS TO REFUGEE CAMPS AT KING PAISAL HOSPITAL, AIRPORT, RED CROSS, ST FAMILLE AND AMAHORO STADIUM.
 - (3) FOUR TEAMS WERE DETAILED TO ESCORT PERSONNEL AND LOGISTICS CONVOY FROM KIGALI TO KAGITUMBA AND BACK.
- 5. UNCIVEOL. THEY ARE ALL IN NAIROBI.
- EUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED FEOPLE COULD NOT TAKE PLACE TODAY DUE TO PIGHTING IN TOWN AND DUE TO THE PACT THAT DROP OFF POINT AT RUNDA WAS NOT SECURE. 70 WOUNDED PEOPLE WERE TRANSFERRED FROM ICRC HOSPITAL TO KING PAISAL HOSPITAL UNDER UNAMIR ESCORT. SOME QUANTITY OF FOOD WAS DELIVERED TO ST MITCHELL ORPHANAGE, VACCINES WERE GIVEN TO RPF DOCTORS IN KAEUGA FOR THE VACCINATING OF WOMEN AND CHILDREN. THE ICRC RECEIVED A RESUPPLY OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES TODAY FOR KING FAISAL AND ICRC HOSPITALS.
