FURTHER ORDER. A RECCE TEAM WAS SENT TO BUKAVU, ZAIRE AND WILL, RETURN ON 14 JULY 94.APC TRAINING COURSE FOR GHANIAN OPERATORS WAS CONTINUED.

- B. DNOMUE. AREA OF OPERATION WAS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS WITHIN THE AREA. BORDER CROSSING FROM UGANDA TO RWANDA: 66 VEHS WITH 406 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 126 REFUGEES. FROM RWANDA TO UGANDA: 61 VEHS WITH 1216 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 979 REFUGEES.ALL THREE HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL. NGOS CONTINUED TO CROSS INTO RWANDA WITH VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ITEMS FOR DISTRIBUTION IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.
- C. GENMATT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS TO SENIOR OFFICERS AND HUMANITARIAN AID CONVOYS. PROVIDED ESCORT FOR FRENCH LIAISON TEAM AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FOR 68 DISPLACED PERSONS.
- D. MILOB. PREPARATION AND PLANNING FOR THE EXPANDED UNAMIR FORCE CONTINUED. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE CITY AND ESCORTED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE CONVOYS WITHIN THE CITY DURING THE PERIOD TO THE FOLLOWING PLACES:
 - (1) DISPLACED PERSONS CAMPS AT MUHURA, GAHINI AND MURAMBI. THEY ALSO AFRAID OF BEING ATTACKED BY MILITIA WHEN THEY RETURNED TO THEIR HOMES.
 - (2) SHORTAGE OF FOOD AND CLOTHING WERE OBSERVED IN THE CAMPS. DISPLACED PERSONS WERE ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPS FOR SERKING FOOD INDIVIDUALLY.
 - (4) ESCORTED OFFICIALS WITHIN KIGALI AND RELIEF OPERATION TRUCKS FROM UGANDA.
 - (5) REPORTED THAT DISPLACED PERSONS CAMPS WERE STILL BEING VACATED BUT ORPHANS REMAINED IN ORPHANAGES. THEY ARE IN URGENT NEED OF FOOD, COOKING UTENSILS AND FURL.
- 5. PREMCE COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. A CONVOY OF MORE THAN 20 TROOPS LEFT GOME FOR KIEUYE YESTERDAY IN THE MORNING AT AFPROXIMATELY 1000HRS. ABOUT 80 SENEGALESE SOLDIERS WERE ALSO DEPLOYED IN KIEUYE YESTERDAY TO STAY THERE. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN AID TO DISPLACED PROFILE WITHIN HPZ.
- 6. UNCIVEOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI AT THE MOMENT.
- 7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. DURING THE PAST 12 HRS THE FOLLOWING TASKS WERE CARRIED OUT:
 - A. DISPLACED PERSONS.
 - (1) RESEARCH FOR DISPLACED PERSONS IN KIGALI CITY. AS DISPLACED PERSONS RETURN TO THEIR HOMES, SOME OF

THEM CAN BE IDENTIFIED.

(2) INPLUX OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO KIGALI INCREASING.
ALL MAJOR REFUGEE CENTERS IN DOWNTOWN ALMOST
EMPTY. REMAINING REFUGEES STILL IN NEED OF BASIC
SUPPLIES, MOST URGENTLY WATER.

B. HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE.

- (1) WATER DELIVERY TO ST FAMILLE AND TANZANIAN EMBASSY.
- (2) PSF ESCORTED IN FOOD DELIVERY TO ECOLE FRANCAISE, ST.MICHEL, SISTERS OF CHARITY AND KING FAYSAL HOSPITAL.
- (3) RECCE TO NDERA AND KAEUGA REFUGEE CAMPS. ACCORDING TO THE AUTHORITIES RESPONSIBLE FOR BOTH CAMPS APPROXIMATELY 954 OF DISPLACED PERSONS WILL DEPART THESE BOTH LOCATIONS FOR KIGALI. REMAINING PERSONS ARE PROM RURAL AREAS AND WILL BE RELOCATED LATER. IN NDERA REFUGEE CAMP THERE IS AN ORPHANAGE WITH 600 CHILDREN AND A HOSPITAL WITH LARGE NUMBER OF PATIENTS. THIS HOSPITAL HAS ONE GERMAN DOCTOR AND TWO NURSES.
- (4) NDERA REFUGEE CAMP AUTHORITY ALSO MENTIONED ABOUT 400 ORPHANS IN NYAGASAMBU REFUGEE CAMP, WHO ARE IN NEED OF BASIC SUPPLIES.
