SITTED COVERING PERIOD 171801B JULY TO 181800B JULY 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION. THE SITUATION REHAINED TENSE IN GISENYI AS RPF CONTINUED THEIR OFFENSIVE OPERATION WITHIN THE AREA. TODAY ABOUT 200 RPF SOLDIERS HERE SEEN IN GENERAL AREA SHABA GRID 3915 WHICH IS ABOUT 7 KMS SOUTH WEST OF GIKONGORO WITHIN THE HUMANITARIAN PROTECTED ZONE. DISPLACED PROPLE AND FLEEING RGF SOLDIERS CONTINUED TO CROSS INTO ZAIRE. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES AND THE ZAIRIAN SECURITY FORCES CONTINUED TO BE VIGILANT AND DISARMED THE FLEEING RGF, HILITIA AND INTERHAMMS. FC AND COOVISITED GOMA. RPF HAVE GIVEN CLEARANCE FOR UNAHIR TO CONDUCT REASONABLE NIGHT MOVEMENTS IN KIGALI AND NORTH-EASTERN AREA FRON TODAY. SRSG LEFT FOR HAIROBI THIS AFTERNOON.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. GENERAL KAGAME WAS REPORTED TO HAVE DECLARED THAT RPF HAD NOW THE WAR AND THAT THERE WAS A DE FACTO CEASE FIRE IN RPF HELD AREAS, WHICH IS ABOUT TWO THIRD OF THE COUNTRY. HE ALSO SAID THAT PASTEUR BIZHUNGU WILL BE THE PRESIDENT OF THE BROAD BASED GOVERNMENT OF NATIONAL UNITY AND FAUSTIN TWAGIRAMUNGU THE PRIME MINISTER. THE INSTALLATION CEREMONY IS SCHEDULED AT 1000 HRS ON 19 JULY 1994. THE SRSG LEFT KIGALI TODAY FOR NAIROBI TO ATTEND A DONORS MEETING AND TO HOLD DISCUSSIONS WITH THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF USAID.

J. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. RPF OPERATIONS AROUND GISENYI CONTINUED WITH MORE ARTY/MORTAR SHELLING. THEY ARE REPORTED TO HAVE DEPLOYED TROOPS IN SOME AREAS INSIDE THE SPZ. 200 SOLDIERS WERE SEEN 7 KMs SOUTH WEST OF GIRONGORO AND MANY MORE IN GR 3915.
- B. RGF. ROF IN THE NORTH WEST OF THE COUNTRY CONTINUE TO PLEE INTO GOMA IN LARGE NUMBERS. IN THE SOUTH WEST OF THE COUNTRY, THEIR ACTIVITIES ARE NOT SIGNIFICANT.
- C. HILITIA. HILITIA AND INTERHANCE CONTINUED TO CROSS INTO EAIRE AT GONA POLLOWING TENSE SITUATION AROUND GISENYI.

4. ONN HILITARY ACTIVITIES

- A. FORCE:HQ. CONTINUED TO CONDUCT ROUTINE WORK, A/DFC PRESIDED MORNING BRIEFING AT 0800 HRS. FC VISITED GONA AND RETURNED THIS AFTERNOON. HE DISCUSSED UNAMIR'S FUTURE DEPLOYMENT IN HPZ WITH BG LAPOURCADE. SRSG HAD A HEETING WITH THE DESIGNATE PRIME MINISTER THIS MORNING. HE LEFT FOR NAIROBI LATER THIS AFTERNOON.
- B. UNCATE. AREA OF OPERATION WAS CALH. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. DETAILS OF BORDER CROSSING ARE AS FOLLOWS:

ALL HELICOPTERS WERE OPERATIONAL. SEVERAL HUMANITARIAM AID AGENCIES CROSSED THE BORDER INTO RWAHDA TO DISTRIBUTE RELIEF ITEMS IN RPF CONTROLLED AREAS.

- C. GHAMBATT. TRAINING ON APCS CONTINUED, PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND FORCE HQ. COMDUCTED PATROLS HITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA FROM 2100 HRS TO 2300 HRS AND FROM 0430 HRS TO 0515 HRS. ABSISTED TO MOVE 771 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM RUTARE TO KIGALI INCORPORATION WITH RPP.
- D. MILOB. THE FOLLOWING TASKS HERE PERFORMED TODAY:
 - (1) CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN THE BYUNBA AREA.
 - (2) ASSISTED TO EVACUATE A TOTAL OF 771 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM RUTARE TO KIGALI.
 - (3) ESCORTED HEF PERSONNEL TO KAGITUMBA AND HEDICAL STORES PLUS FOOD ITEMS TO KIGALI.
- 5. YEARCH COALITION FORCES ACTIVITIES. THE FRENCH COALITION FORCES REMAINED VIGILANT THROUGHOUT. THEY CONTINUED TO DISARM RGF TROOPS AND HILITIA. THEY CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUHAHITARIAN ASSISTANCE IN COORDINATION WITH OTHER HUHAHITARIAN AID AGENCIES. OVER ONE MILLION DISPLACED PERSONS ARE REPORTED TO HAVE CROSSED THE BORDER: INTO GOMA, ZAIRE. BN SIZE TROOPS ARE DEPLOYED IN GENERAL AREAS OF KIBUYE, GIKONGORD AND CYANGUGU. THEY CONTINUED TO DISARM RGF AND INTERHAMME.
- 6. UNCIVPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI.
- 7. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES
 - A. DISPLACED PERSONS
 - (1) HAC EVACUATED DISPLACED PERSONS FROM THE HERIDIEN HOTEL WITH THE CO-OPERATION OF THE COHHITTEE CHAIRMAN FOR THE REFUGEES. 12 DISPLACED PERSONS REMAINED IN THE BASEMENT OF THE HOTEL AWAITING TRANSPORTATION TO BYUHBA AND BUTARE AREAS.
