*in recognition of its collective superior performance from 9 September 2001 to 12 April 2002. During this period, the Squadron was directly responsible for unprecedented combat intelligence and combat operations support during extraordinarily sensitive operations under direct supervision of the National Security Council. In only two weeks after the 11 September 2001 terrorist attacks, the Squadron deployed its first airborne asset in Afghanistan. It accomplished numerous, historic MQ-1B Predator events, including the first-ever time-critical targeting for hunter-killer operations during Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. The Expeditionary Air Intelligence Squadron's exemplary accomplishments reflect credit upon its members, their respective organizations, and the Intelligence Community.*
