[The President and H.R. Haldeman discussed the imminent arrival of President Luis Echeverría Alvarez]

Nixon: [Unintelligible.]

Haldeman: Oh, we're getting some mileage out of the Mexican, he's been quite cooperative.

Nixon: I know he has, but what I meant is the state business...

Haldeman: (Interrupts) I know. He's being politically cooperative, he's moving around the country where *we* want him to go. He's meeting with our Spanish-American appointees. He's doing some stuff in L.A. and Texas and in Chicago, where we've got Mexicans and it'll do us some good. He said – he asked us if he could be helpful in any way.
