1. ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ - ENTIRE TEXT
2. Just prior to reftelecon Ambassador held long discussion with Minister of Presidency Carlos Flores at which latter gave Ambassador copy of GOH instructions to Honduran UN Permrep.
3. Instructions contain following points:
 - (a) To expose lack of Nicaraguan proof regarding charges of Honduran army involvement in internal Nicaraguan affairs and to recall Nicaraguan violations of Honduran

sovereignty and territorial integrity;

(b) To accuse Nicaragua of having disrupted military equilibrium in Central America (NOTE: GOH instructions review bill of particulars in this regard in extensive detail);

(c) To accuse Nicaragua directly of sponsoring arms traffic, ~~terrorism~~ terrorism, and subversive movements in the region as well as attempting to maintain state of tension in Central America;

(d) Honduras reaffirms that Nicaragua has a fundamental internal problem of growing opposition generated by unfulfilled promises which in turn have caused an armed struggle within Nicaragua's own territory. All the armed activities which have been the subject of Sandinista protest have taken place inside Nicaragua by opponents of the regime. In disregard of this internal problem Nicaragua has sought to implicate third parties with the premeditated purpose of internationalizing its internal conflict;

(e) Insist on the necessity of regional dialogue at the level of Foreign Ministers with a view to reaching ~~global solution~~ comprehensive solution.

4. Subsequent to reftelecon Ambassador spoke again with Minister Flores who was aware of latest UN developments.

Flores said that GOH instructions to Permrep were to

continue insistence on regional approach and to insist on Contadora report to OAS prior to considering whether or not Perez de Cuellar should form part of Contadora Group. Honduras does not reject possible SYG involvement at some future time but insists on report to OAS from Contadora Four before proceeding further along that track. Flores also said that Honduran Permrep will attend Kirkpatrick breakfast May ten. He also suggested that consideration be given to inviting Guatemalan Permrep if possible.
