When I saw General Alvarez on other matters morning March 10, he took opportunity to recall his recent remarks to Under Secretary Ikle, Ambassador Kirkpatrick and others to the effect the USG should play strong behind-the-scenes role in identifying and promoting capable and politically moderate Salvadoran military officers. Alvarez then read to me from paper containing a number of names and biographic sketches of key Salvadoran military officials.
