1. EMPLOYEE'S JOB: INCUMBENT IS UNITED STATES AMBASSADOR TO HONDURAS. HE DIRECTS A MISSION COM-  
PRISED OF REPRESENTATIVES OF EIGHT U.S. GOVERNMENT  
DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES. AUTHORIZED AMERICAN AND  
NATIONAL COMPLEMENTS ARE 139 AND 125 PERSONS, RESPEC-  
TIVELY. IN ADDITION, THERE ARE MORE THAN 240 PEACE  
CORPS VOLUNTEERS IN HONDURAS, INCLUDING TRAINEES.  
U.S. GOVERNMENT TDY PERSONNEL, NOT COUNTING THOSE ON  
MILITARY EXERCISES, NUMBER BETWEEN 75 AND 130 AT ANY  
GIVEN TIME.

2. WORK REQUIREMENTS:

A. CONTINUING RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE THE EFFECTIVE  
OPERATION AND COORDINATION OF THE U.S. MISSION AND ITS  
PROGRAMS; REPRESENTATION AND PROTECTION OF U.S. INTER-  
ESTS; ESTABLISHMENT OF EFFECTIVE RELATIONSHIPS WITH  
KEY LOCAL LEADERS; ANALYSIS OF MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS AND  
TRENDS IN HONDURAS, ESPECIALLY AS THEY RELATE TO U.S.  
POLICIES AND INTERESTS; AND PROMOTION OF COMMERCIAL,  
CULTURAL AND OTHER EXCHANGES.

B. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES DURING THE RATING PERIOD  
INCLUDE ENCOURAGING, AS APPROPRIATE, THE CONTINUED  
CONSOLIDATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT; ADVISING  
THE HONDURAN GOVERNMENT IN THE FORMULATION AND IMPLI-  
MENTATION OF SOUND ECONOMIC POLICIES; GUIDING THE USA'S  
INCREASED ECONOMIC AND DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE EFFORTS  
IN HONDURAS WHICH SURPASSED THE \$2 MILLION LEVEL IN  
FY-83; AND OVERSEEING A SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASED U.S.  
MILITARY EXERCISE AND TRAINING EFFORT IN HONDURAS  
WHICH AT ITS PEAK WILL INVOLVE 6000 U.S. TROOPS IN  
COUNTRY.
